## ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL AND UNEXCUSED ABSENCES

The 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR STARTS ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 16, 2023. **All students are expected to report to school on the first day, Wednesday, August 16, 2023. Students who have not attended the first day of school will be dropped at the end of the first day of school.** Students who are dropped will not be guaranteed a seat at the school and may have to be overloaded to other schools upon return. The only exceptions will be students who are absent due to illness. If a student is absent the first day due to illness, parents or guardians must notify the school every day the student is absent. **Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.** (AR5113.1). After 10 days of consecutive (uninterrupted) school days of unexcused absences, a student is dropped from the roster and must re-enroll at the district office. No exceptions will be made.

## END OF THE YEAR CHECKLIST

- Library Books - All library books are due **now**. Please be sure your child has returned all library books to our school library.
- Textbooks - Students are responsible for all books assigned to them. Lost or damaged textbooks must be paid for before the report card is issued.
- Medication - Please pick up your child's medication by June 2nd. If not picked up, the medication will be discarded. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Lost and Found - Check for any lost articles. Any items left on June 2nd will be donated.

## **YEARBOOKS**

There is a limited number of yearbooks available for purchase in the office. The cost is \$33. EXACT CHANGE AND CASH ONLY will be accepted.

## **FALL 2023-2024 UPDATE & MAZE PROCESS**

MAZE is Fremont Unified School District's annual registration confirmation process in which parents/guardians:

- provide required information for each enrolled student - such as emergency contacts,
- acknowledge certain parent/guardian and student rights and responsibilities, and
- access specific school forms/information.

Completing the MAZE process ensures your student's school has accurate information, and allows families to view student schedules/classroom assignments and their teachers when that information is released in August. MAZE forms for all FUSD students must be completed online through the [Infinite Campus \(IC\) Parent Portal](#). **The window to complete the MAZE process for the 2023-24 school year is July 17 to August 7, 2023.**

While MAZE forms will not be available until July 17, we strongly recommend that you take a few moments and log into your [IC Parent Portal](#) now to address any access issues. [Click here for IC Parent Portal troubleshooting and support.](#)

**Please DO NOT complete the New Student Registration as it will duplicate your student(s).**

Parents/Guardians will receive a notice with MAZE information at the email address indicated in the [IC Parent Portal](#), and updates will be posted to both the [FUSD](#) and school websites.

## **HEALTH CARE NEEDS/ MEDICATION FORMS FOR 2023-2024**

Does your student need to take medication at school or have a health condition we should be aware of? Please be sure to go to <https://fUSD-ca.schoolloop.com/healthforms> to find all the health care and medication forms that need to be completed by your student's primary care provider. Orders for the 2023-2024 school year must be dated 6/3/23 or later to be valid for the full school year. Please pick up any medications that are currently at school by June 2. Any medication left after that date will be disposed of.

## **END OF YEAR MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL**

If your student has required medication or health services at school this year, all medication and medical supplies must be picked up from the school office by the last day of school! Medications must be picked up by a parent or guardian unless your student is authorized (current contract on file) to self-carry his/her medication. Please pick up any medications that are currently at school by June 2. Any medication left after that date will be disposed of.
