Welcome to the 2025-2026 school year! My name is Dr. Ronaldo Fisher, and I am the principal of John F. Kennedy High School.

I am excited to be entering my third year as the principal of John F. Kennedy High School, and eager to be a part of another fantastic year at Kennedy. As this year begins, the focus in conversation with students will be on impact over influence. Our students are faced with daily choices, and it is our job to help them discern what is priority and what is not, and what will make the best and largest impact in their educational and life endeavors and what will not, or possibly set them back in their overall growth, relationships and goals. Our teachers use the Professional Learning Community (PLC) model to meet as collaborative teams and plan for the best possible academic support and extension scenarios for our students. Kennedy High School has been named a National Model PLC (Professional Learning Community) School due to our efforts to use data and informed practices to better serve our students.

This year, we are entering our twelfth year as a Title I school. As part of this process, **every family** is required to click on this link, [Titan Compact](#) in order to complete and digitally confirm agreement with the Titan Compact as part of the electronic Maze Day procedure.

The *Titan Compact* is a 3 – Way – Pledge between parents, students, and staff which clarifies the roles and commitments we are willing to make in order to ensure that our students succeed.

The *Titan Compact* is based on our adopted Essential Behaviors, (P.R.I.D.E)

- P**-repared for Learning: All Titans (students and staff) are prepared for learning to take place. This means that we arrive on time and are free from distractions that impede our ability to learn.
- R**-espect for All: All Titans (students and staff) respect each other and themselves. This will be accomplished through self-regulation (identifying when to use of academically driven language vs. social language), development of empathy towards others and community building.
- I**-mpact “What kind of *impact* will I have on the school? On others? On my own success? On my future? We will be developing “I Statements” which help us all to reflect and create positive impacts on each other. Yet also, holding ourselves accountable for our actions. n
- D**-iscipline: Discipline (in the positive sense) is applying *grit* to overcome distractions and obstacles in order to stay on course. We will succeed through setting goals and holding ourselves accountable to those goals.
- E**-xplore: **All Titans** can go beyond what they know (comfort) and will develop a growth mindset to explore new opportunities for success / problem solving. This will be summarized by the question, “What is my plus?”

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At the core of this philosophy are the Four Essential Questions that drive our work here at JFK:

1. **What do we expect students to learn?** The teachers are establishing 7-10 essential standards for each course which identify what students *need to know* in order to be successful at the next level. This is aligned to our Guaranteed Viable Curriculum (GVC) for all students in all courses/subjects. This has been done through many hours of discussion and debate by each department.
2. **How do we know when each student has learned it?** The staff continues with creation of common assessments (tests) and ways to truly check for understanding during units in order to ensure our students are learning, and more importantly, how to identify students who need intervention and follow up on material and concepts *before* they fail. This is a work in progress and our staff have committed to ongoing professional development in order to reach this goal for each course and department.
3. **How will we respond when some students do not learn it?** The intervention piece is an integral part of the PLC process. The Titan staff has agreed that the best approach to intervention is **immediate** support and **intervention** during the school day. This is known as Titan Up at our school. 4 days a week, 30 minutes each of the days that is held with importance and relevance. This is a monumental task continuously being worked on and changed to meet the needs of student within the context of the semester and overall year. In short, our staff is committed to serving our students in a way that helps them to succeed with immediate and very calculated support, without students having to come before and after school.
4. **How will we respond when some already know it?** It is just as important for our staff to develop **enrichment/extension** opportunities that further challenge our students when they understand concepts. Every lesson and activity will have components attached which will allow us to explore levels of depth and rigor as students begin to master concepts.

The staff has continued to incorporate Claims Evidence Reasoning (CER) and three common strategies into lessons which have proven to help our students' access higher level thinking skills. These strategies are referred to as "The Big Three". When applied in the classroom and at home, these strategies help students better analyze and process what they are learning:

They are (1) Annotation, (2) Cornell Notes, and (3) Compare and Contrast.

Over the past nineteen years, as a science teacher, then Assistant Principal and now the Principal of JFK, I have always been encouraged and excited about the display of grit from our students and community through the rough times, and the enthusiasm and celebration through exciting times. It doesn't matter if you are entering with us for the first time as a Titan, or if you are headed into your final year with us, once you are a Titan you are always a Titan!

As always, I continue to encourage all members of our community to get involved and be as active as possible, (i.e. parent groups, KTFG, Kennedy Boosters and ELAC). Try to attend our Family conferences in late October, Title I Parent Night, Parent Café, ELAC meetings, college nights, student extracurricular performances and athletic events to help support their growth. Take every opportunity to become a member of this Titan family and join us!
