I am looking forward to the 2023-2024 school year.

The first day of school is August 16 and is a minimum day ending at 1:10 pm. All school days begin at 8:30 am. On Monday, Thursdays and Fridays school ends at 3:26. MAZE day for 9th grade students will include a Link Crew station that will include a tour of the campus. After each tour, students will participate in community building exercises led by members of the Peer Advocate class.

At Washington High School we are committed to teaching students the skills they need to succeed in the 21st century, with one of the primary skills being technological literacy. Our goal is ultimately to have a 1:1 ratio of computers to students. We are getting closer to this goal, and this past year we were able to acquire several additional class sets of laptop computers.

As many of you are aware, Washington added a new scoreboard to the gym two years ago, and we now have perfect sightlines from every seat in the gym. Eighty percent of the lockers on the Washington campus are recently installed. Performances take place in a brand new theater and we built a Wellness Center in rm. 91. The Maker Space is completely functional and includes ten 3-D printers, and we are working on improving the cafeteria facilities, as this is where the community gathers for meetings and concerts.

We will continue to make these types of investments in the facilities at Washington High School, but we need your help.
