<u>Approval of last meetings minutes:</u> Rob Reibenschuh made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 4, 2019 meeting. Dawn Nogueiro seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous to approve the minutes. Members absent at the last meeting abstained from the vote.

Approval of Agenda: Dawn Nogueiro made a motion to approve the agenda.. Jeff Downing seconded the motion. The agenda was approved unanimously.

Oral Communications: Comments from public or members on items not on agenda: none

<u>CTO Update:</u> (Joe Siam) Michael Murray introduced himself and represented the IT Department at the meeting. He presented the CTO Update. Openings in the department continue with one open position for a Data Specialist in the Data Dvision, and an open position for a Systems Specialist in the Systems Division. The IT department continues to increase security due to spear phishing attacks—emails to staff from outside now include a text alert about trusting the sender and not clicking on links. An RFP is being reviewed for network electronics for the three new schools. IT support division is also looking at the RFP

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regarding a possible manual scanning process to archive the boxes of paper now in storage (mainly attendance records). Regarding the new fixtures for the clock/bell/speaker project and the microphone issue, a pilot site is being establish to demonstrate how the system works. It was noted that there are both a finanacial and time cost FUSD and the mostly the vendor to run the pilot.

Barth Paine reported on the FUSD website. Websites are in the realignment stage. Not all schools are on the website yet, but FUSD was given a 15 day extension to help with the needed connections between SchoolLoop, Alameda County Office of Education (ACOE) and Blackboard. Fremont Adult and Continuing Education (FACE aka Adult School) has also had adapt including a new url FACE edu that points to the regular url. FACE will continue to use Blackboard one more year at a cost of \$2,000. FACE has its own student information system that wraps to the website. Barth continues to work with their web person on the transition. One member commented that the new sites are bright and enticing, but the realignment may have inadvertantly created a mess underneath. Support and training is needed to clearn up these issues where possible. TAC then discussed training for staff, and members noted that some sessions have been held, a help doc will be shared with staff and more information will go to staff in the bi-monthly Staff Update. Yellow errors can be ignored for now—that is finetuning that will be needed for Americans with Disability (ADA) access.

TAC then asked about the staff email trnsition plans from Outlook to Gmail. Michael noted that his understanding is that the transition plan will go to the board in the near future. It will be the school board's choice to choose the timing of the implementation. TAC members noted that a multi-pronged approach to transining is important. One member wants TAC to look at the content of the trainings and agreed that a subcommittee for this is a possible approach.

Members also asked whether the school bus GPS/routing system and the Visitor Badge systems has ever been approved or were being used in FUSD. Consensus was that neither of the systems have been implemented. Other members noted that the school district is holding informational meetings about the budget for 2019-20 and that information is on the front page of the FUSD website.

Another member asked if the IT Department is out of teacher computers. Michael noted that he wasn't sure as that is part of the IT Support Division and Mary Lasica was not present to respond.

New Business included the mention that it is time to recruit people to apply for TAC, commit to re-apply etc. Robert Hou and Joe Siam are the contacts for this.
