


Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year. All of us here at Ardenwood Elementary are very excited to have students return to in-person learning this year and we wish you and your family a successful school year. Please be sure to routinely check our <u>school's website</u>, the <u>district's website</u>, and monitor your email for important school communications throughout the year.

I am sure that you have many questions regarding how the start of the school year will look for our Ardenwood Dragons. Safety of our students continues to be of the highest importance to us, and I encourage you to review the Fremont Unified School District's COVID-19 Safety Plan (CSP), as well as review Ardenwood Elementary's site-specific Safety Protocols. These protocols will be updated as needed and any updates will be sent to the Dragon community.

While this information is found in both the district's COVID-19 Safety Plan and our own site-specific Safety Protocols, I would like to call your attention to the requirement that all students will be required to wear a face mask while on campus (both inside and outside the classroom). Families are expected to provide their child with their own face mask, but Ardenwood does have a supply of replacement masks for students who damage, soil, or misplace their mask while on campus. Parents/ Guardians are not allowed on campus at this time. We understand the need to assist your child during the first days of the school year in locating their classroom. Each day, prior to arriving at school, all families will need to review with their children the Daily COVID-19 Health Screening Questionnaire (no physical copy needs to be printed or brought to school).

It is my privilege to share the wonderful news that Ardenwood Elementary has been awarded the distinction of being a <u>National PTA School of Excellence</u>. Only 351 schools across the nation were given this designation in recognition of their commitment to building an inclusive and welcoming school-community where all families contribute to enriching the educational experience and overall well-being for all students. Ardenwood Campus COVID-19 Protocol

⇒ Prior to Arriving at School

Every morning, parents/guardians must review and complete a <u>Daily COVID-19 Health Screening</u> <u>questionnaire</u> for each of their children. If all questions on the questionnaire are responded to with a "No," the child may physically come to school. To the extent possible, only one parent/caregiver should accompany the child to school and will not be permitted into areas reserved only for student and staff access. To the extent possible, if a student is being dropped off at one of the two vehicle loops, the driver should remain within the vehicle. All students on campus must arrive wearing a face covering and continue to wear their face covering while at school.

⇒ Departure from School

The same supervised locations/gates used for student arrival will be used for student dismissal. Parents/guardians are encouraged to pick up their child in the same place they were dropped off to avoid confusion. While picking up their child from school, all adults must wear a face covering. Loading zones are marked with social distancing floor markings. Drivers should remain in their vehicle to the extent possible when using the two available drive through loops. Families that elect to walk their children home may meet their child at the pick-up curb but may not congregate or wait for them at that location.

- ⇒ Until further notice, we sadly will not be welcoming parent/community volunteers on campus. However, we are recruiting for Noon Supervisors to help us monitor the safety of the students. If interested, please visit the EdJoin website to apply.

Welcome to the 2021-22 school year! This school year has a certain amount of uncertainty to it, but PTA has been hard at work making sure we are thinking of con-


