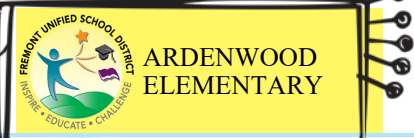

## School Site Council Election

Each Fremont Unified School District school must have an elected School Site Council (SSC) to represent parents, students, community members, and school staff in the school governance process. The SSC has a number of important responsibilities, including:

- Reviewing and analyzing student achievement data,
- gathering community input,
- helping develop the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) and the school site budget,
- and monitoring the implementation of the plan and budget.

The [School Site Council](#) is composed of two membership groups; members who are school employees (principal, teachers, and classified staff) and members that represent the community (parents, guardians, or other community members). Membership on the SSC is a two (2) year commitment. Two parent/guardian vacancies on the SSC will need to be filled for the 21-22 school year. Ardenwood encourages you to join the SSC. Nomination and Election information will be set out at the start of next year.
