**IV. District English Learners Advisory Committee (DELAC) Updates**

Ardenwood ELAC Representative Ms. Sanchez discussed updates to FUSD Universal Kindergarten that will roll out over the course of the next few school years. TK will become

available for progressively younger students, and the TK classroom would always be supported by two adults (a credentialed teacher and a classified paraprofessional).

Across the district, current English Learners were reclassified as Fluent English Proficient this year after the results of i-Ready Diagnostic 1 and 2 results were known. This is a change from previously only being able to reclassify students one late in the year after ELA

The district is looking to continue to support EL students at high percentage/needs schools through an EL specialist. Ardenwood does not qualify for this support due to our enrollment numbers.

**V. Annual Review of SPSA Goals for 2021-2022**

Elie led the council through a mid-year analysis of current goals through a [shared presentation](#). Information regarding current status and potential changes for next year's goals were discussed. Plans were made to review new goal language for the 2022-2023 school year during the next meeting.

**VI. LCAP Pass Through Funds for 2022-2023**
