



Go Dragons!





School Accountability Report Card

4th-6th Grade Families

FUSD's Comprehensive Health, Puberty, and Sexuality Education (CHPSE) curriculum for **Grades 4 through 6** focuses on information that is essential for students' well-being. This course of study conforms strictly to the guidelines provided by the <u>California State Education Code 51933</u>, the <u>California Healthy Youth Act</u>, and will be taught during the 2021-2022 school year.

More information regarding our CHPSE curriculum and the dates selected for that program's instruction will be given to you during the third trimester. You will be provided advance notice of these lessons as well as information about opt-out requests. FALL 2022-2023 Continuing Student Enrollment:

Reservation Forms will NOT be Mailed Home

FUSD has made the decision that the FALL 2022-2023 Reservation Form/Residency Verification paperwork will NOT be mailed home this spring in part due to increased parent traffic at the school sites amid pandemic concerns. Instead, online submission of residency verification/proofs via your IC Parent Portal will be required <u>during July-August MAZE Days</u> prior to school beginning on Wednesday, August 17, 2022.

If your child will not be attending Ardenwood or any other FUSD school in the fall, please email our office staff so they may ensure your child's school records are ready to be sent to their next school.

Elementary students in grades TK – 5th grades currently enrolled at Ardenwood School will be automatically rolled over to attend Ardenwood in the FALL, provided they are to remain enrolled with us on the last day of school, June 6th. Exceptions are:

- TK students with a different home school will roll over to their home school
- Students overloaded to Ardenwood this year who are called back to their home school for the fall
- Students attending Ardenwood on an Intra-district transfer must reapply annually to be approved to continue
- Special Education students requiring an alternate school program Parents are required to notify us in the event of a change in residency. If you have already moved or plan to move after April 1, 2022, your child will be able to finish out the school year with us, but it is to your advantage to let us know within 5 days of your move (AR 5111.1) so that your child is enrolled at their new FUSD school for the fall. Their new enrollment date prioritizes them to attend their home school.

Please complete and email the <u>Change of Address Form</u> along with 2 residency proofs of your new address to our School Secretary, Carla Leon (<u>cleon@fusdk12.net</u>), for processing. This ensures you receive school and district mailings.
