


## How can parents partner with the school?

#### **School Site Council (SSC)**

The SSC is made up of school personnel, parents, and community stakeholders. The SSC monitors the implementation of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA), which is the document that guides Ardenwood's instruction and social-emotional programs, and is developed to ensure continuous school improvement. This group also oversees the spending of certain funds provided through the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP).

#### **English Language Advisory Committee (ELAC)**

The purpose of the ELAC is to advocate for student English Learners and to advise the principal and school staff on programs and services for English learners as well as the School Site Council on the development of the SPSA. ELAC reviews the school's program for English Learners, including the school's needs assessment, reviewing the school's annual language census, and makes efforts to increase parents' awareness of the importance of regular school attendance. The committee may elect at least one member to the District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC).

All SSC/ELAC meetings are open to the public. Meetings this year will be held via Zoom. An agenda for each meeting will be posted online at least 72 hours before the meeting date. Contact the office for information on how to be a part of any of these meetings.
