

#### **FUSD Policies Regarding Volunteers on Campus**

Volunteers who have received clearance at a school must sign in and out, must wear a visitor badge at all times, and must follow all site-specific protocols.

#### **Volunteer Clearance**

All volunteers must submit an application through <u>CiviCore</u>. (effective 9/23/22) in order to receive clearance. Volunteers who are at a school under the direct supervision of a certificated employee must remain under the supervision of that employee for the duration of their visit.

## A message from our PTA President




Hello Dragon Families,

#### **ENROLLMENT INFORMATION**

- Current \$tudents: Families of current students will receive a mailing in February 2023 that includes a 2023-2024 Reservation/Residency Verification form. On this form you will indicate if your child will be returning to Fremont Unified School District or not. You will also provide 2 updated proofs of residency at that time (lease/mortgage statement, utility bill, pay stub, official government mailing).
- ⇒ Timelines for enrollment at **Junior High/Middle \$chool** are being determined and will be shared with students/families/staff as soon as possible.
  - Please check this link for information and how-to videos for New Student Enrollment information for the 2022-2023 School Year. If you have a preschooler, be sure to read the information and be prepared to register during the PRIORITY enrollment period. The Priority Enrollment Period for TK, K and Sibling (new TK-5 grades) student enrollment is January 23 April 6, 2023.
