


This week we celebrate the 100th day of school! Thank you for your continued support in a most challenging year, and together we look forward to a successful second half of the school year. As our school works to mitigate potential spread and exposure to COVID-19, I would like to thank all families for doing their due diligence in reviewing the **Daily Symptom Checker.** We take student safety seriously, and please note that when a child reports they are not feeling well or is observed by an adult to be sick, they will be sent home. While we wish for all students to benefit from in-person instruction and do not wish to cause any family an inconvenience, judicious adherence to our district's and county guidelines will help protect our community. Ardenwood continues to have onsite COVID-19 PCR testing every Monday from 7 am to 3 pm. Parents/Guardians must be present to have their child tested, and prior to testing should complete a one-time online registration. For more information, please visit www.fremont.k12.ca.us/covidtest. In a number of circumstances, students may be eligible to return early from their quarantine with a negative result from an at-home rapid antigen test. Every household in the U.S. can order one set of 4 free at-home tests through USPS. You may consider ordering your free tests now so you have access to them in the future if a need arises. Please watch for a "FALL 22-23 Reservation/Registration Form" to be mailed home on February 1st for each student currently enrolled in TK-5th grades. The form will NOT be handed out to parents and serves 2 purposes: it reserves a spot for your child next year at Ardenwood and also fulfills the District's mandated annual residency verification via USPS.

Form and residency proofs are due to Ardenwood on or before the due date of March 4, 2022!

Students will not be allowed to attend classes nor register without a shot record of a Tdap booster. Make an after school appointment for Tdap with your physician if your child has yet to have the immunization and turn in the supporting document(s) to the school office.
