




Hello Dragons,



As we look forward to a busy couple of months, we also are reflecting on some of our learnings since the beginning of the school year. Students continue to strive to meet the Ardenwood school wide rules: Be Safe, Be Respectful and Be Responsible. To this end, I would like to provide a few reminders, 1) Students should walk on campus (not run) except during PE or recess and only in the designated areas-blacktop and grass, 2) Students should seek support from teachers or staff to help resolve studentstudent issues or concerns and 3) Students should use appropriate language and keep their hands to themselves. Please continue to remind your student(s) of the Ardenwood rules and especially these important focus items. We are seeing some wonderful growth in our students and hope to continue this progress.

Finally, we have noticed a few students bringing devices to school (eg., cell phones, tablets) and wanted to remind families of the rules around technology. Elementary students shall not carry these devices unless by a doctor's request for medical necessity or at the discretion of the administrator. Consistent with this policy, recordings of any kind are not allowed in classrooms or anywhere on the school campus without the written consent of teachers and/or administrators. 


