

Just a friendly reminder...

We strongly recommend that you take a few moments and log into your IC Parent Portal now to address any access issues before MAZE window, when wait times for support may increase. Each parent/guardian should have access to all of their enrolled students through their IC Parent Portal.

Please continue to update information as needed throughout the school year with your school office; having current contact information is vital in the case of an emergency.

FALL 2022-2023 UPDATE

How will I learn who my child's Teacher will be for Next School Year?

MAZE Day Explained:

You will be required to access your <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u> beginning July 18th, 2022 and complete the registration online.

Parents will be asked for the following:

- ⇒ Upload 2 proofs of residency documents
- ⇒ Update their child's emergency contacts
- ⇒ Acknowledge Annual Notice of Rights and Agreements

Submissions will be approved in the order received and parents will receive an email verifying the information has been accepted.

Your child's teacher and class assignment will then be released in August 12th when you log back in to your IC Parent Portal.

Completing the ONLINE MAZE process ensures your student's school has accurate information. The window to complete the MAZE forms for the 2022-2023 school year is from July 18th through the first day of school, August 17th. (Any submissions done before July 18th will be considered invalid.)

Throughout the summer, parents/guardians will receive updated MAZE information at the email address indicated in the IC Parent Portal. These updates will also be posted in the FUSD website.


