






Attendance on the First Day of School

All students are expected to report to school on the FIRST day, Wednesday, August 17. Students who do not attend the FIRST day of school will be dropped at the end of the FIRST day of school. Students who are dropped will not be guaranteed a seat at the school and may have to be overloaded to other schools upon return. The only exception will be students who are absent due to illness. If a student is absent the FIRST day due to illness, parents or guardians must notify the school every day the student is absent. Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified. (BP/AR 5113.1)
