Dear Ardenwood Families.

Ask any student what they are excited about for the month of April, and chances are you will hear in return, "Spring Break!" Ardenwood hopes that the coming vacation for your child brings opportunity for fun and relaxation. Spring Break is from Friday 4/19 through Friday 4/26. As a reminder, the Thursday before Spring Break on 4/18 is a minimum day.

Please note that Ardenwood students in grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 will be soon be taking the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). Ardenwood's CAASPP testing window is between 4/29 and 5/24. More information about the CAASPP is available within this newsletter and on the FUSD website.

Please put our students' safety first and stop at all cross walks so our students can cross the streets safely. Drivers must follow the safety directions of our crossing guards and traffic volunteers. Please do not drop your students off in the middle of any street as it creates a traffic backlog and is unsafe for our students. Do not allow your student to run across the street. Encourage them to use designated crosswalks and loading zones. Please review with your students the safe way to cross the street. It is important for students to stop at the curb, before crossing, and look both ways. It is also important for students to pay attention while walking in the crosswalk. Fall Registration for Currently Enrolled TK-5th Grade Students

The majority of currently enrolled Ardenwood students are now registered for the 2019-2010 school year. Families that have not enrolled their students for next year were notified via the final mailing to submit the outstanding 2019-2020 Reservation Form that has already been sent out. Those students whose parent/guardian has not returned their forms need to be aware that their child does not have space being held at this time; as Ardenwood has not received their completed 2019-2020 Reservation Form. We would like to thank all the families who submitted their paperwork by the due date!

After School Programs

Please be aware that it is the parent's responsibility to deliver their children to any after school programs on campus. Please mark your calendar with the start and end dates for the program so as not to forget to pick up your child when the program ends. Teachers are not responsible to walk students to their respective after school programs. Be sure to pick up your child(ren) at the time the after school program ends to avoid a rush to the office and your child calling you to be picked up from school.

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP)

The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress, or CAASPP, is the state academic testing program. CAASPP is a system intended to provide information that can be used to monitor student progress and ensure that all students leave high school ready for college and career. Like last year, CAASPP includes computer-based tests in English language arts, mathematics, and science. Students in grades 3-8 and 11 will take the computer adaptive tests in English and math in spring of 2019. Students in grades 5, 8, and an assigned high school grade will also take the tests in science.

Please see the Ardenwood test schedule below to determine the dates of testing for your student. It is extremely important to avoid scheduling trips or appointments on the dates that your student is scheduled to test. Following the spring testing, students will receive individual score reports. Student score reports will be electronically distributed to parents/guardians in late summer/early fall and will include an overall score, and description of the student's achievement level for English language arts, mathematics, and science if applicable. Parents and guardians have the right to exempt their child from taking the CAASPP assessments. If you have any questions or concerns regarding your child's participation, please contact your school's principal.

Comprehensive Health, Puberty, and Sexuality Education (CHPSE)

Students in grades 4, 5, and 6 will receive instruction in the Comprehensive Health, Puberty, and Sexuality Education (CHPSE). The materials that will be used will be FUSD's adopted CHPSE curriculum, "Rights, Respect, and Responsibility (3Rs)." This curriculum is now available for parents to review in the Ardenwood office. If you would like to review the CHPSE curriculum, please stop by the Ardenwood office. In addition, please note that parents have the right to have their child participate in CHPSE in one of three ways: 1) Attend all sessions. 2) Opt-out of ALL sessions. Or 3) Opt-out of selected sessions. Please visit https://fusd-ca.schoolloop.com/healthresources for more information. Parents who choose to NOT have their child participate in CHPSE sessions should notify their child's teacher.



- Reviewing and analyzing student achievement data,
- · gathering community input,
- helping develop the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) and the school site budget,
- and monitoring the implementation of the plan and budget.

The School Site Council is composed of two membership groups; members who are school employees (principal, teachers, and classified staff) and members that represent the community (parents, guardians, or other community members). Membership on the SSC is a two (2) year commitment. For the 2018-2019 school year, the following parents were on the SSC:
