**III. Review Meeting Minutes from 10-19-21**

**IV. Update on Parent/Guardian Membership Vacancy**

Ardenwood continues to have a single vacant parent/guardian member seat on the SSC. This position would be best filled by a parent/guardian of a current English Language Learner so that the ELAC subcommittee could have both parent/guardian and staff representation. The committee brainstormed outreach and recruitment ideas.

**V. i-Ready Diagnostic Assessment Data Fall 2021**

Principal Wasser provided the committee with an overview of i-Ready Diagnostic 1 data in the areas of Mathematics and Reading for grades 1 through 6. Kindergarten students, who are assessed through ESGI and not i-Ready, do not take a Fall assessment. The goal for the 2021-2022 school year is to reduce the number of Tier 2 and Tier 3 students by 50%. The results of the i-Ready Fall assessment was used to generate a student list of in-school intervention participants.

**VI. Review LCAP Intervention Funds Allocation**

The initial allocation of intervention funds was made prior to the site learning it would have a half-time Intervention Teacher assigned to the site. As a result, budgeting decisions were originally made to provide for certificated hours to conduct intervention before and/or after the school day. The committee discussed the reallocation of funds to other intervention priorities but no change to the current allocation was made.
