### **II. Reviewed Comprehensive School Safety Plan (CSSP)**

Plan includes 2 goals for school safety plan that have to do with student discipline which Elie Wasser suggested we change/update/review. New school leadership often brings a new direction for school goals.

Elie Wasser recommended a change to the first school goal to include measuring the number of student mental and physical supports. For example, keeping record of how many students are referred to counselors and resource specialists as a result of the COST program. Mr. Wasser also recommended a change to the school's second safety goal to include improving our emergency response readiness (ie classroom backpacks and safety supply shed).

#### *Additional safety concerns and suggestions:*

Shelby Data, a teacher rep from our safety committee, suggested emailing teachers to check on the status of their classroom emergency backpacks.

Question was posed as to what funds replenish the safety materials.

Krista reminded the group of "Kid Power" presentations. Caitlin suggested reaching out to Kaiser Permanente for their presentation called "Peace Signs". Both of these supports are free to schools.

Teachers spoke about the shop ticket holders that hold the emergency cards and the need to update that supply. Carole shared the suggestion about color coding the lanyard to identify students with allergies.

Mr. Wasser brought up need to clean and organize safety shed. Perhaps parents may be able to volunteer to help clean and organize materials in the shed.

Additional school safety concern was voiced about parents signing into office and wearing volunteer stickers when on campus due to our open campus.
