IV. Priority Discussion for 2019-2020: Elie

A. Fremont Youth & Family Services Counselor: \$8000 2 days/week for clinical intern (Jessica Yang this year) and 1 district employed 2 days/wk (Russell Sass this year)....next year Elie propose increasing the intern to 3 days per week

3 incidences with upper and 1 lower grades that are self harm (did not happen on campus) that were brought to teacher's attention and was able to refer to clinical intern

B. Intervention: semester or full day planning time staff would like to better able to serve their students

C. SST/SART Coordination: SST was part of 40 hours in the past, Elie would like to have it be one person who coordinates rather than putting up dates

D. Lending Library: Caitlin: books in boxes in library still, teachers have had a positive response to it. Room 27A needs to be cleared.

Suggestion made to donate items to the Paradise area. Krista suggested a school wide drive for those teachers

E. School-Wide Expectation Signs:

Elie would like signs that show what it means to be Safe, Respectful, Responsible in different areas of the school (library, lunch room, playground, classroom, etc.) and to do activities with teachers to have the rules agreed on by all teachers.

Challenge: to have a visual and writing that is meaningful to all grade levels

F. Training for Noon-Supervisors

Here for about 2 hours during the day. Elie would like to have a training for an hour at the start of the year or semester to get trained on procedures and how to report injuries, etc.

G. Materials to Support Small Group Instruction

Ex: dedicated section for small group computer learning

H. Traffic Safety Monitors

Sangeeta commented about the Ardenwood Walking School bus where students would walk students from Frederick to Emilia where a crossing guard is and then go back for another group, Krista mentioned had student crossing guard

Caitlin commented that it could be a 40 hour position if a parent can not supervise them
