Hello Azevada All Star Families!

It is hard to believe that we are now beginning the month of June! It has been a very unusual end of the school year for all of us but it is now time for us to plan for the ending of this school year and the summer months ahead.

This week (June 1 – 5) will be the last week that our teachers will be providing online instruction, classwork, and/or homework to students. This is because we are beginning the process of collecting school materials and distributing student personal materials this week. We know that by collecting the school materials now, we may be disrupting the ability for teachers to provide online instruction. Because of this, next week (June 8-10), which is our last week of school, teachers will be planning enjoyable online events to celebrate the end of the school year.

Late last week, we received guidelines from the district for how we will end this school year and collect school materials. At Azevada, we will be collecting student materials (such as classroom textbooks, classroom library books, Azevada library books, chrome books and hot spots) using a "drive through" collection process. With this process, we will ask for parents to remain inside their car. The process will be as follows:

- All parents and family members who are inside the car must be wearing masks and gloves.
- All volunteers at Azevada, who will be helping with the collection process, will also be wearing masks and gloves.
- When parents arrive to the school, they will arrive with a large piece of paper on their car dashboard. On the large piece of paper, we ask that parents write their child's/children's <u>First and Last Name(s)</u>, <u>Grade Level(s)</u>, and <u>Room</u> <u>Number(s)</u>. (This information will assist the volunteers.)
- At the specific date and time (see the schedule below), parents will drive into the larger valet parking lot. Volunteers will guide parents as they slowly drive their car through the parking lot to Stations where the following materials will be collected:
 - Station #1 Classroom Books Turn-in Station (where classroom textbooks and classroom library books will be collected by a volunteer).
 - **Station #2 Library Books Turn-in Station** (where Azevada library books will be collected by a volunteer. Some families may not have Library Books to return).
 - **Station #3 Chrome book & Hot Spot Turn-in Station** (where school chrome books and hot spots will be collected by a volunteer. Some families will not have chrome books and/or hot spots to turn in).
 - Station #4 Student Personal Materials Pick-up Station (where the student's personal materials will be retrieved and then returned to the family. Some families may not have materials to pick up).

- Medication Pick-up Station If parents need to collect student medication from the office, then we will ask the parent to park on Royal Palm Drive. A volunteer will assist the parent to retrieve the medication from the office.
- **Questions** If parents have questions or need extra assistance, we will ask them to park their vehicle on Royal Palm Drive. A volunteer will assist the parent.
- Once finished, parents will exit the parking lot.

SPECIAL NOTE:

For families with children at multiple grade levels at Azevada, they may choose any one of the date/time options (that corresponds to the grade level of one of their children). The family may come to school at their preferred date/time option to participate in the "drive through" collection process. This way parents will only have to come to school one time.
