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Maze Day 2022/2023

MAZE is Fremont Unified School District's annual registration confirmation process in which parents/guardians:

- provide required information for each enrolled student - such as emergency contacts and current proof of residency,
- acknowledge certain parent/guardian and student rights and responsibilities, and
- access specific school forms/information.

Completing the MAZE process ensures your student's school has accurate information, and allows families to view student schedules/classroom assignments and their teachers when that information is released in August.

MAZE forms for all FUSD students must be completed online through the [Infinite Campus \(IC\) Parent Portal](#). The window to complete the MAZE process for the 2022-23 school year is July 18 through the first day of school: August 17, 2022.

We strongly recommend that you take a few moments and log into your [IC Parent Portal](#) now to address any access issues before the MAZE window, when wait times for support may increase. Each parent/guardian should have access to all of their enrolled students through their IC Parent Portal. [Click here for IC Parent Portal troubleshooting and support.](#)

Throughout the summer, parents/guardians will receive updated MAZE information at the email address indicated in the [IC Parent Portal](#), and updates will be posted to both the [FUSD](#) and school websites.

- **IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL & REASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS**
The 2022-2023 School Year begins on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. All students are expected to report to school on the first day. Students who have not attended the first day of school will be dropped from enrollment and or transferred to another school. Seats can not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.

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New Alameda County Indoor Masking Order

Alameda County will require masking in most indoor public settings starting Friday, June 3, per a new [Health Officer Order](#) the Alameda County Public Health Department [announced today, June 2](#). This does not apply to TK-12 school settings through the end of the 2021-22 school year, including our end-of-year student events and graduation ceremonies. Masking continues to be strongly recommended indoors in all FUSD facilities, and we invite students and staff to mask in compliance with this Order starting tomorrow.

Starting Thursday, June 9, all employees, students and others entering FUSD facilities will be required to wear masks indoors, except while working alone in a closed office or room, or actively eating and/or drinking. FUSD Immersion Programs Update

At the FUSD Board of Education meeting on February 23, 2022, the Board of Education trustees voted to unify FUSD's immersion programs. This long-considered decision means that in 2022-23, the Mandarin Immersion Program (MIP) will unify at Lila Bringhurst Elementary as that school opens to serve its home attendance area students, and the Spanish Dual Immersion (SDI) program will unify at Blacow Elementary. This allows both programs to continue to grow, without displacing neighborhood students at the unification sites.



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Elementary Report Cards and CAASPP Student Score Reports

Elementary report cards and CAASPP (SBAC, CAST, and CAA) student score reports will be available electronically in your Illuminate Parent Portal this summer. Paper versions of the CAASPP student score reports will also be mailed home to families in July/August 2022.

Here are instructions on how to access your Illuminate parent portal. If you did not receive an access code, you'll need to contact your school office as soon as possible. School offices are only open through Thursday, June 9th. If you don't get access prior to the close of the school year, you will have to wait until offices reopen on Tuesday, August 9th to receive support.

Volunteers on Campus for the 2022-23 school year

Since March 1, 2022, volunteers have been able to return to FUSD facilities after meeting the following criteria:

- Volunteers must have approval of the principal/designee and teacher to enter a classroom.
- Volunteers must provide valid photo identification.
- Per FUSD Board of Education action on February 9, 2022:
 - Only one volunteer per classroom is allowed on campus at a time.
 - Volunteers must complete a health/symptom screener.
 - Volunteers must provide proof of vaccination:
 - Per Alameda County Public Health (ACPH), people are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as Pfizer or Moderna, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as J & J. The vaccines must be authorized either by the Food and Drug Administration or World Health Organization.

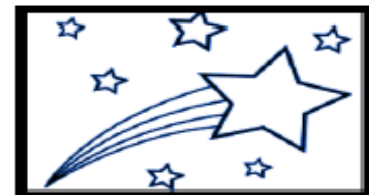
