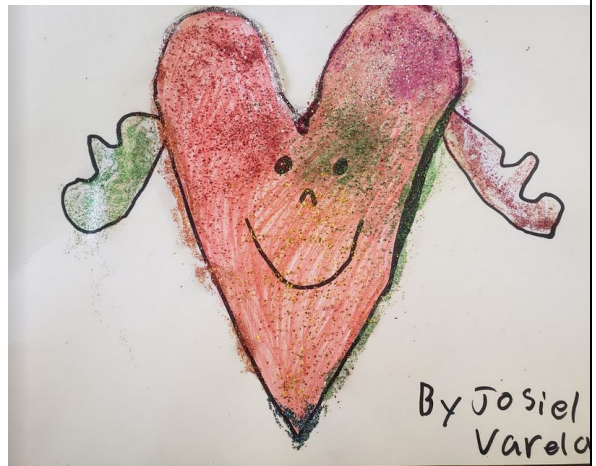

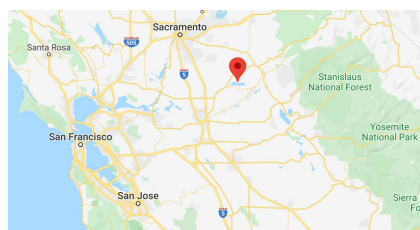

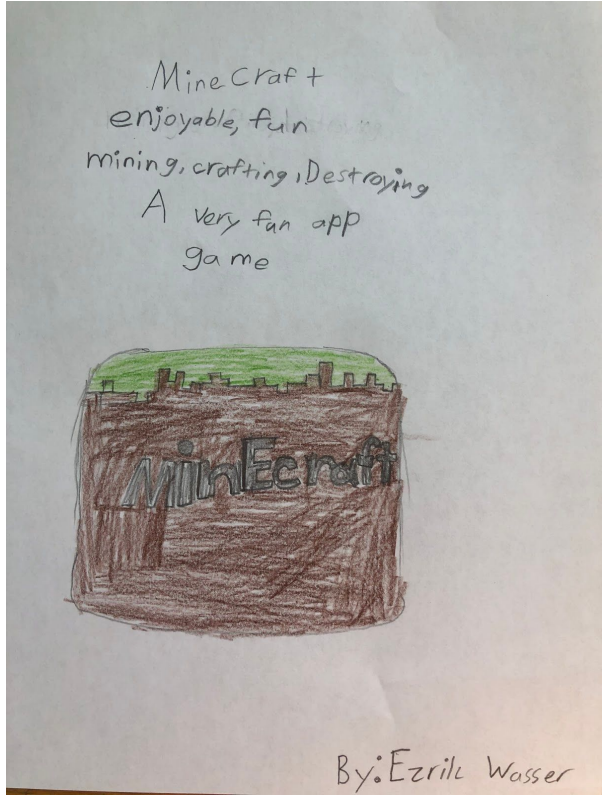
What is your favorite season? Why?

reasons why summer is my favorite season.

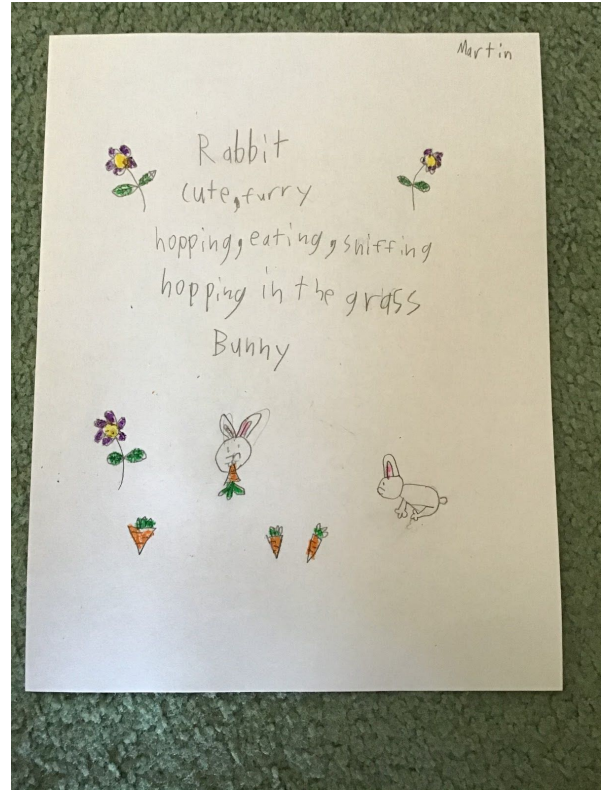

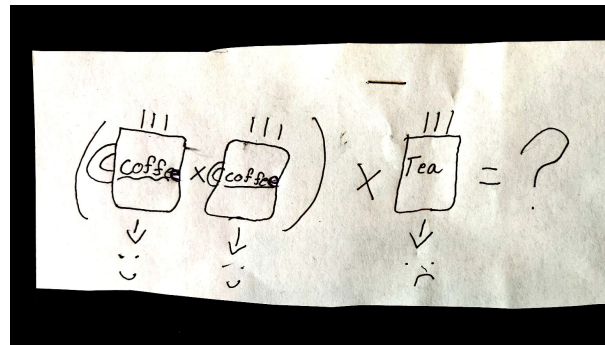
