Dear Families,

On **Friday, October 25, from 6:00pm-8:00pm**, Azevada will be holding our annual Fall Festival. This will be a fun evening for all. It is also a fundraising opportunity for classroom teachers in each grade level. Money earned by each classroom will be used to plan events and purchase classroom supplies for use during this school year. We hope that you and your family will be able to join us!

We invite everyone to join us for the Fall Festival, which will be held on school grounds. There will be a variety of carnival games and raffles for children and adults to enjoy. Food items will also be available for purchase in the cafeteria.

#### **Festival Game Tickets and Pre-Sale**

The price of the Fall Festival carnival game tickets will be four tickets for \$1.00. The cost to play each carnival game will vary, but will cost between 1-4 tickets per game. To reduce the amount of time that families must spend in line to buy tickets while at the festival, we will be preselling carnival game tickets before and after school on October 21, 22, 23 and 24 (at the office). Tickets can also be purchased at the event.

#### **Raffle Tickets and Pre-Sale**

In addition, each Grade Level will have the opportunity to raffle a theme basket of new and donated items. We will be preselling raffle tickets for Grade Level Baskets on October 21, 22, 23 and 24 (at the office) and they will be sold at the festival for \$1.00 each. This is an additional fundraising opportunity for the classrooms. All profits raised through the raffle and games ticket sales will stay in its own grade level and/or classroom funding.

#### **Costume Parade**

This year we will have a costume parade on **Thursday, October 31** lead by our principal. The parade will begin at approximately 2pm on the Azevada blacktop and the parade route will be around the perimeter of the school. All Azevada families are invited to join us for the costume parade. Students **MAY** wear their *school appropriate* costumes to school on Thursday, October 31. Please remember we do not allow clown costumes, masks, weapons or costumes with blood or gore. Please also note that Thursday, October 31 is **NOT** a minimum day at Azevada.
