1. UPDATES FROM MRS. DIAMOND:

- **Questions submitted via the online “Lunch Time Chat” document:**
 - **Question #1** = Hi, my child had an English assessment test from FUSD last month, and the result shows she needs extra help for her English. However, they haven't provided more information about it. May I know if the school will provide extra help for English learners ? Thank you so much.
 - **Answer** = *All California teachers are required to be credentialed to teach English Learner students. In FUSD, all classrooms are made up of both EL students and non-EL students. Your child’s classroom teacher provides the additional English language support within their instructional day (during both whole class and small group instructional periods). Additionally, all EL students are “language tested” (using the ELPAC assessment) when they enter FUSD. EL students are then tested yearly (during the months of Feb - April) until they are “reclassified” (which means that the ELPAC testing results show that the child no longer needs extra support in the English language). Parents are notified of testing results after the testing window closes. If you have not already, please reach out to your child’s teacher for further information about how your child is receiving additional English language support.*

2. ADDITIONAL UPDATES:

- **FUSD Reopening Plan:**
 - *No changes. To learn more, please tune into the live broadcasts of the FUSD School Board Meetings (or watch the recordings available on the FUSD website).*
- **Distance Learning Update:**
 - *No changes. We will continue in the district learning (online) format until further notice. We will be notified by FUSD when/if we return to the school building.*
- **Trimester 2 Dates:**
 - Jan. 22, 2021 = Trimester 2 Progress Report Period Ends. Progress Reports sent home.
 - March 5, 2021 = Trimester 2 Ends. (Report cards go home by March 19, 2020).
- **MIP/SDI Task Force Update:**
 - The Role of the Task Force: The MIP/SDI Task Force will gather, analyze, review, and consider information and data to provide recommendations to the Board of Education to consider short term and long term solutions for both the Mandarin Immersion Program and the Spanish Dual Immersion Programs.
 - After much discussion and review of data reports, the Task Force is bringing recommendations to the FUSD School Board on **Feb. 10, 2021**. (The recommendations listed below are still in draft form and may be worded differently once they are finalized (with costs, etc.).)

- Recommendations for MIP program are (in no particular order):
 - The entire MIP program moves to Bringhurst Elementary (if the Board decides that the school can be opened).
 - Co-locate to one site: The MIP program stays at Azevada as a K-5 / K-6 program (with two MI classrooms at each grade level). A second K-5 / K-6 strand begins at a school where there is/will be room. Schools recommended for the second strand are Blacow, Grimmer, and Brookvale. (This option means that two (of our current four) classrooms of Kinder students would move to the other school in Fall 2021. This also means that the second school would have two Kinder MI classrooms and two 1st grade MI classrooms next year. Details of figuring out who goes to that school have not been determined as of yet.)
 - Alternative Proposal - Move the new MIP Kinder classes to Blacow in Fall 2021 until Bringhurst is available for the entire program.
- Recommendations for the SDI program are (in no particular order):
 - The entire SDI program moves to Bringhurst Elementary (if the Board decides that the school can be opened).
 - The entire SDI program moves to Grimmer Elementary. (There are additional considerations that will need to be made if this option is chosen.)
 - The program (which is currently in 3 schools) will move into 2 schools in Fall 2021. Schools currently recommended are Grimmer + Blacow and Grimmer + Vallejo Mill.
- These recommendations will be discussed by the FUSD School Board at the **Feb. 10, 2021** meeting. The FUSD School Board will make all final decisions. We are currently not aware of when final decisions will be made.
