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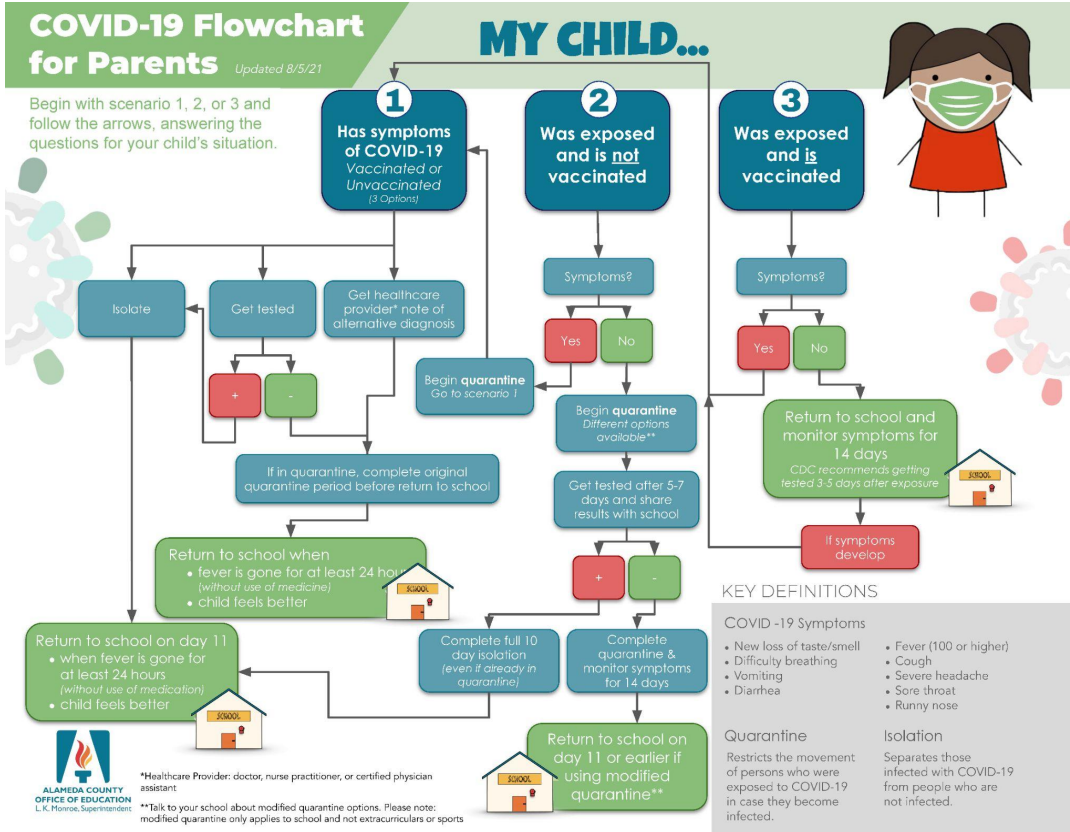
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## Modified & Shortened Quarantine

New California Public Health Department (CPDH) Guidance for Schools  
Supporting in-person instruction with fewer missed days

### What is Modified Quarantine?

**Modified quarantine:** a period of time (typically 7-10 days) during which STUDENTS may continue in-person instruction (with exception of activities where a mask cannot be worn, e.g. band) but should refrain from all extracurricular activities at school including sports as well as activities within the community setting. Modified quarantine does not apply to staff.

#### Who qualifies for Modified Quarantine?

Asymptomatic, unvaccinated students exposed to COVID-19 when both parties were wearing a mask in any school setting (indoor or outdoor) supervised by school staff. Modified Quarantine applies to exposure in school settings ONLY.

A student is considered exposed when they have close contact with a positive case. Close contacts are people who had:

- A total of ≥15 minutes over a 24-hour period within 6 feet of a COVID-19 positive person when that person was contagious, even if both people were wearing masks; OR
- Unprotected direct contact for any length of time with an infected person's sneeze, saliva, or cough.

#### What are students permitted to do in Modified Quarantine?

- Attend class in person (with masks)
- Participate in recess or P.E. (masks are strongly encouraged outdoors)
- Use of school transportation (with masks)

#### Not permitted:

Participation in extracurricular activities

#### Modified Quarantine Requires

##### Masking



Facemasks can protect students from transmission and allow them to continue in-class learning

##### Twice-Weekly Testing



Twice-weekly testing during modified quarantine provides an additional layer of safety and monitoring. Test immediately. The second test should be at least 3 days after the first test. If the test is negative on or after day 6, they may exit quarantine on day 8. **Testing for modified quarantine MUST be supervised (e.g. at school or health care provider's office).**

### What is Shortened Quarantine?

Shortened quarantine applies to:

- Masked or unmasked unvaccinated close contacts who remain asymptomatic.

If no symptoms, release from quarantine:

- On day 11 after date of last exposure with no test.
- On day 8 (or later) if test is taken on or after day 6 and result is negative.



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## Special Announcement

### All FUSD student meals will be FREE for the school year 2021 - 2022 Breakfast and Lunch @ Azevada!

Student meals will be free for all on-campus FUSD students aged 2-18 years. Students do not need to meet any eligibility standards to receive meals at no cost. Because meals are free, there will be NO Free and Reduced Meal Applications to fill out for this school year!

Breakfast will be available in the Azevada cafeteria between the hours of 7:45 - 8:15am. When students have finished eating breakfast, they will need to wait in the cafeteria until 8:15am (when they are able to go to the blacktop). Breakfast Supervisors will be present and students will be expected to follow all directions given.

Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day, including during the breakfast period. Please park off campus and walk your child to the gates outside the cafeteria. Students will be supervised in the cafeteria between the hours of 7:45am and 8:15am.

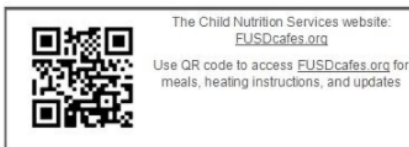
## FREE Student Meals Child Nutrition Services School Year 2021-2022

All FUSD student meals will be FREE for the school year 2021-2022.

Lunch, breakfast, and second chance/recess breakfast (at the school sites with a breakfast program) will be free for all on-campus FUSD students 2 to 18 years old. Students do not need to meet any eligibility standards to receive meals at no cost.

Because meals are free there will be NO Free and Reduced Price Meal Application to fill out this school year 2021-2022.

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## **AZEVADA NEW SCHOOL YEAR PROCEDURES**

### **Azevada Site Protocols for the Return to School**

(Revised 8/11/21)

#### **OFFICE AND VOLUNTEER PROTOCOLS:**

- The Azevada Office will open to the public on August 10, 2021.
  - Although open, we will enact a revised policy in an effort to reduce the number of social interactions due to Covid-19 safety protocols.
- In adherence to the FUSD Covid-19 safety protocols, all students, visitors, and school site employees will wear appropriate face coverings (masks) while on the school campus.
- Other than the school office area, at this time and in adherence to the FUSD Covid-10 safety protocols, visitors and volunteers will not be allowed inside any school buildings until further notice.

#### **Before School (while at home) Procedures:**

#### **BEFORE LEAVING HOME TO COME TO SCHOOL:**

- FUSD has implemented the following protocols (subject to change based on local and state guidance):
  - Students (with the assistance of their parents/guardians) will complete a home based screening [Daily COVID-19 Health Screening](#) each day, prior to entering the school, or being transported via FUSD busing services. The home based screener will be provided to families prior to the start of the instructional year.
  - If “yes” is answered to any of the screener questions, please DO NOT report to school and please contact your medical professional as needed.
  - If a student must be quarantined, the parent/guardian will contact the school office to arrange for school work and/or homework. Every attempt will be made to provide school work/homework using online resources.
- Parents/guardians and staff will notify school administration immediately if the student or staff tested positive for COVID-19 or if one of the household members or non-household close contacts tested positive for COVID-19.
- Parents/guardians should assist students to ensure they have their school materials and a face covering (face mask).
- Reminder: Every adult and student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)

#### **Before the School Day / Student Drop-off Procedures:**

#### **PARKING @ AZEVADA:**

- All families of students in grades K-6 will need to park off campus. The reason for this is because we have more full time staff members at Azevada than we have parking spaces in our parking lots.
- We ask that all families kindly park off campus so that staff members can more easily move their materials to their classrooms.
- To help limit the number of people on campus before school, we ask that ONE family member walk their grade K-6 students onto the Azevada campus grounds.



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## **BEGINNING OF THE DAY DROP-OFF (GRADES 1-6):**

- Families of Grade 1-6 students will need to park off campus and walk their students on to campus.
- Reminder: Every adult and student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)
- Grade 1-6 students and families who arrive at Azevada before 8:15am will need to wait outside the black gates at the front of the school until the 8:15am bell rings.
- When the 8:15am bell rings, students and ONE family member may walk to the blacktop. (No students are allowed on the blacktop before 8:15am because there is no supervision.)
- If it is raining:
  - When the 8:15am bell rings, grade 1-6 students will walk directly to their classroom.
  - Students will wait at their classroom door (out of the rain) until their teacher arrives.

## **BEGINNING OF THE DAY DROP-OFF (KINDERGARTEN):**

- Families of Grade K students will need to park off campus and walk their students to the Kindergarten gate.
- Reminder: Every adult and student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)
- Families should wait with their child at the Kindergarten gate.
- Kindergarten teachers will meet parents/guardians at the gate and will help students enter the Kindergarten playground.
- There will be no change to these procedures if it is raining.
- Due to limited spacing, parents/guardians will not be allowed to enter the Kindergarten playground or the Kindergarten classrooms.
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the office.)

## **BEGINNING OF THE DAY DROP-OFF (SPECIAL DAY CLASS STUDENTS):**

- Grade TK-5 Special Day Class students who are arriving by school district transportation, will be dropped off in front of the Azevada Office area (using the Valet drop off zone in the drive-through driveway).
  - Grade TK-5 Special Day Class staff will meet students in the drop-off area. Staff will assist students to their classrooms.
- Families of Grade TK-5 Special Day Class students, who drive their students to school, will receive a special Azevada pass that will allow them to drive into the drive-through driveway.
  - Grade TK-5 Special Day Class staff will meet students in the drop-off area. Staff will assist students to their classrooms.
- Reminder: Every adult and student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the school office.)



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**BEFORE SCHOOL PLAYGROUND USE @ 8:15-8:30am (GRADES 1-6):**

- Grade 1-6 students and families who arrive at Azevada before 8:15am will need to wait outside the black gates at the front of the school until the 8:15am bell rings.
- When the 8:15am bell rings, students and ONE family member may walk to the blacktop. (No students are allowed on the blacktop before 8:15am because there is no supervision.)
- Please remember that every adult and every grade K-6 student must be wearing a face covering while on the Azevada campus.
- If it is raining:
  - When the 8:15am bell rings, grade 1-6 students will walk directly to their classroom.
  - Students will wait at their classroom door (out of the rain) until their teacher arrives. Students will not be allowed to play on the blacktop.

**BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL DAY @ 8:30am (GRADES 1-6):**

- When the 8:30am bell rings, we will ask ALL students to FREEZE. (When the FREEZE bell rings, all students should stop playing, running, and talking).
- A teacher on yard duty will blow their whistle. This signals that students should WALK to their classroom line.
- Classroom teachers will pick up their class from the classroom line and they will walk their students to class.
- At this time, parents/guardians should exit the school.
- If it is raining, classroom teachers will meet their students at their classroom door.
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the office.)

**During the School Day Procedures:**

**VISITORS and VOLUNTEERS:**

- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day.
- Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the office.)

**FACE COVERINGS:**

- Reminder: Every adult and every student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)

**STUDENTS:**

- Should students be exposed to COVID or exhibit COVID like symptoms we will follow the following protocol [English](#) [Mandarin](#) [Spanish](#)

**SOCIAL DISTANCING:**

- Because all K-6 students and all adults will be wearing face coverings, students will be socially distanced as appropriate but there is currently no specific requirement that students must be separated from their peers or adults by a specific number of feet.





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## MOVEMENT THROUGH THE SCHOOL DURING SCHOOL DAY:

- When moving through the all adult staff and students will walk on one side and will “stay to the right” when walking through hallways, etc.
- Social distancing will be encouraged.
- School staff will continually monitor and remind students, as necessary.

## RECESS TIME (GRADES 1-6):

- During recess play time, all grade 1-6 students and all adults will need to wear their face coverings.
- Students in grades 1-3 and students in grades 4-6 will have separate recess times.
- During recess, the students will be able to use the entire blacktop area (thus allowing more play area for all students at recess).
- Each classroom will have an assortment of recess play time equipment. (Students are not allowed to bring their own balls and play equipment to school, because we are supplying the play equipment that they will use during recess time.)
- During and after recess time, students will have access to and will be encouraged to use hand washing and hand sanitizing stations.
- If it is raining, students will remain in their classroom for recess time.

## RECESS TIME / SNACK RECESS TIME (GRADE K):

- During recess play time, all grade K students and all adults will need to wear their face coverings.
- Students will only be allowed to remove their masks when they are actively eating/drinking their snacks.
- When seated to eat their snack, students will be seated a minimum of three feet apart.
- Once students have finished eating, they will be reminded to put their face covering back on, and then they will be able to play on the Kindergarten playground for the remainder of their recess time.
- At the beginning, during, and after recess / snack time, students will have access to and will be encouraged to use hand washing and hand sanitizing stations.
- If it is raining, students will remain in their classroom for recess time.

## LUNCH TIME (GRADES 1-6):

- During lunch recess time, all grade 1-6 students and all adults will need to wear their face coverings.
- Students in grades 1-3 and students in grades 4-6 will have separate lunch times.
- Students will only be allowed to remove their face coverings when they are actively eating/drinking their lunches.
- When seated to eat lunch, students will have access to indoor seating areas and outdoor seating areas.
- In all seating areas, there will be markers indicating where students are and are not allowed to sit to eat. (Because they will need to remove their face coverings, students will be seated a minimum of three feet apart while they are eating at lunch time.)
- Once students have finished eating their lunch, they will be reminded to put their face covering back on, and then they will be able to play on the blacktop for the remainder of their lunch time period.
- At the beginning, during and after lunch time, students will have access to and will be encouraged to use hand washing and hand sanitizing stations.
- If it is raining:
  - Students will remain in their classroom during lunchtime, where they will eat lunch.
  - Prior to the rainy season, teachers will develop a seating arrangement in their classroom so that students can be socially distanced while eating their lunch (with their face covering off).
  - Lunchtime supervisors will monitor students while they eat and while they have indoor recess time.
  - Students will be reminded to put their face coverings back on when they have finished eating.



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- At the beginning, during and after lunch time, students will have access to and will be encouraged to use hand washing and hand sanitizing stations.
- Teachers will meet students at their classroom at the end of lunchtime.

**Dismissal / End of School Day / Student Pick-up Procedures:**

**STUDENT PICK-UP (GRADES 1-6):**

- Families of Grade K-6 students will need to park off campus and walk to the front of the school.
- All visitors and family members must wear a face covering while they are on the school campus.
- All visitors and family will need to wait outside the black gates at the front of the school until the end of the school day bell rings.
  - The end of the school day is @ 3:00pm on M, T, Th, Fr (regular days), and @ 1:20pm on W (and all other Minimum Days).
- When the end of the school day bell rings, we prefer that visitors and families NOT walk into the Azevada campus. (Be sure to check in with your child's teacher to learn which gate your child will exit through at the end of the school day.)
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the office.)

**STUDENT PICK-UP (GRADE K):**

- Families of Grade K students will need to park off campus and walk their students to the Kindergarten gate.
- All visitors and family members must wear a face covering when they are on the school campus.
- All visitors and family members will need to wait outside the Kindergarten gate at the front of the school until the end of the Kindergarten school day.
  - The end of the school day for our AM-Kinder students is @ 11:30am (Regular Days) and @ 11:30am (Overlap Days).  
 The end of the school day for our PM-Kinder is @ 3:00pm (Regular Day) and @ 1:20pm (Overlap Days).
- At the end of the Kindergarten day, Kindergarten teachers will release the students to their parents/ care-givers. Kindergarten teachers will notify parents if their end of the day pick-up location is in a location other than the Kindergarten gate area.
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the office.)

**END OF DAY PROCEDURES (SPECIAL DAY CLASS STUDENTS):**

- Grade TK-5 Special Day Class students who are going home via school district transportation will be picked up by the district bus in front of the Azevada Office area (via the Valet drop off zone in the drive-through driveway).
  - Grade TK-5 Special Day Class staff will assist the students in boarding the busses.
- Families of Grade TK-5 Special Day Class students, who pick up their students from school, will receive a special Azevada pass that will allow them to drive into the drive-through driveway.
  - Grade TK-5 Special Day Class staff will assist the students as they meet their parents/chaperones..
- Reminder: Every adult and student must wear a face covering while on campus @ Azevada. (Please note: Face coverings should be worn properly. Face coverings must cover both the mouth and nose. It must fit snugly against the side of the face.)
- Please note that, at this time, no parents/guardians or visitors are allowed to enter any school classroom or school building during the school day. Parents/guardians and visitors are also currently not allowed to enter the school classroom or other school buildings before school and after school. (The only exception is that parents/guardians and visitors may enter the school office.)



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## CURRICULUM & INSTRUCTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE PARENT VOLUNTEER ANNOUNCEMENT

In order to guide the District on implementation of the California State Standards and the resulting shifts of classroom instruction, FUSD has a Curriculum and Instruction Advisory Committee. As stakeholders, the Committee's responsibility is to advise and give input into the District's Curriculum & Instruction planning, by reviewing/recommending curriculum and materials that are high quality and equitable and advising in relevant instructional matters. The committee may also oversee special task forces as commissioned by the Board of Trustees on specific topics of interest to the community.

The members of the Curriculum and Instruction Advisory Committee will serve a (2) two-year term. The membership of the Committee should reflect the diversity of the community and the student body. **The Governing Board is currently seeking four (4) parents to serve on the Curriculum and Instruction Advisory Committee.** The members of the committee will be selected from those who apply for the position by filling out an application and submitting it to the Curriculum and Instruction Director, Mrs. Kim Kelly, by the due date.
