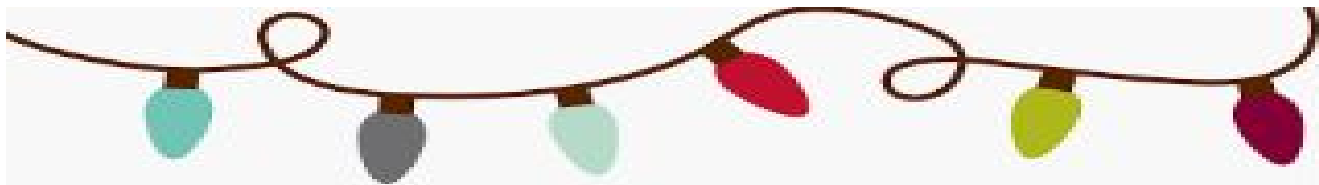

**2019-2020 School Year Enrollment Update**

New enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year will begin in December. If you currently have a student attending a Fremont Unified school in grades TK-5<sup>th</sup>, you may be eligible to enroll your “new” student during the sibling priority period. You may check your eligibility at your home school between November and December 19, 2018.

Priority enrollment for new TK and Kindergarten students for 2019-2020 will begin January 14, 2019 and run through February 22, 2019. ## School Calendar Survey

Dear Parent/Guardian Community,

The School Calendar Committee has extended the timeline to **December 10th**. The committee has been working diligently to develop a survey for all stakeholders to provide input. The survey results will lead to Fremont Unified School District and Fremont Unified District Teachers Association to work collaboratively to look at possible school year changes that will affect all students in the district. One change includes finishing the junior/middle and high school first semester before winter break. As a result, school will start earlier for all students. This survey will ask all of the stakeholders: Students, Parents, and Staff to provide input. The following prompts identify possible start dates, breaks, and the end-time of the school year. California Ed. Code 46208 requires that there be 180 school days.

We are asking all parents/guardians to also ask their 5th through 12th grade students to participate in the survey.
