GATE SCHOOL YEAR 2022/2023 UPDATE

Fremont Unified School District (FUSD) provides support for gifted and talented (GATE) students through differentiated instruction. We believe that differentiated instruction not only serves the needs of our exceptional students, but also enhances the entire educational program for all students.

In February of 2020, funding for the CogAT testing was cut as part of the budget savings. While the CogAT testing has been the primary means of qualifying students for GATE identification, we are now in the process of identifying an alternative way of identifying students. There will not be a test for GATE eligibility given this year. We are currently revising the GATE identification process and handbook FUSD will have an update by Spring 2023.

During the 2022/2023 school year we will continue to identify 5th and 6th grade students who were **not identified** in an earlier grade. These students may be considered for GATE identification through the professional judgement nominate process. Teachers and/or parents may student. A completed nomination form must be submitted by the teacher or parent to the school Principal by December 15, 2022. Principals will set up meetings with the teacher, student, and parent to discuss the student's eligibility for GATE identification. In June 2023, parents, teachers, and students who applied for professional judgement will be informed of their child's GATE eligibility.

Signing Students Out Early: If you need to sign your child out of school for a doctor appointment early, please be prepared to show valid ID to confirm your identity as either the parent/guardian or approved emergency contact, arriving early and noting recess/lunch time schedules. Emailing the teacher as a courtesy is helpful.

2022-2023 Brookvale Volunteer Policy: All School Volunteers are Required to Register on CiviCore

It is a simple process. All volunteers will be required to upload their Driver's License. Parents volunteering to drive for a field trip are also required to upload their Automobile Insurance Declaration Page (which clearly lists liability amounts, names of covered drivers, vehicle make/model and vehicle license plate).

- The minimum liability coverage required is noted on the DECLARATION OF PARENT/VOLUNTEER DRIVER OF FUSD STUDENT form, which you will need to access via the front page as part of the application process. In blue letters you will see "click here"
- By clicking on the button, you will be able to find forms needed which are specific to your volunteer category.
