 7th Grade Advancement Immunization Requirements: 1) Tdap (Whooping Cough) received after 7th birthday; 2nd Varicella (Chicken Pox). Please bring your child's proof of immunizations to Brookvale by May 26, 2023 or schedule an appointment for your child to receive the required immunization(s), if you have not already done so. After this date, you will be required to wait until Thornton reopens in August 2023 to provide proof. Your student may not attend in-person learning or activities if non-compliant
