


Please watch for a "FALL 2023-2024 Reservation/Registration Form" to be mailed home soon for each student *currently* enrolled in TK – 6^{th} grades. The form will *not* be handed out to parents and serves 2 purposes: it reserves a spot for your child next year at Brookvale and also fulfills the District's mandated annual residency verification via USPS. *Please don't mistake the letter for junk mail and toss it out!*

• For students who will be moving on to junior high next year, Brookvale will collect the form and proofs and communicate with Thornton to confirm a space will be reserved for next year.

By submitting the required form and Residency Proofs by <u>February 24th</u>, your child will be reserved a space for next year.

*The forms must be returned to the school that your student currently is attending; if you have a student overloaded to another elementary school, please return it there. If you are moving across town or changing apartment numbers, FUSD Board Policy states the family *must inform the school within 5 days of your moving date or of any change in circumstance which would affect their student's residency* (AR 5111.1).

Please be sure to reach out to our office if you have moved recently so that the Continuing Student Reservation Form/Proof of Residency reaches you this month. We are committed to working with you on the address change and on allowing your student to continue their current enrollment.
