Please ensure your child's immunization record is updated:

• 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Advancement Immunization Requirements: 1) Tdap (Whooping Cough) received after 7<sup>th</sup> birthday; 2<sup>nd</sup> Varicella (Chicken Pox). Please bring your child's proof of immunizations to Brookvale by May 26, 2023 or schedule an appointment for your child to receive the required immunization(s), if you have not already done so. After this date, you will be required to wait until Thornton reopens in August 2023 to provide proof. Your student may not attend in-person learning or activities if non-compliant

Thornton Registration packets were due to your child's classroom teacher on 3/8/2023. Online Registration should also be completed per the instructions attached to your child's form.

#### STUDENT PLACEMENT INPUT

The placement of students in each class for next year is decided by the administration and the faculty. Student placement is a complex process with many variables, each of which must be considered. The following criteria are used in order to accomplish the placement of students: academic needs, behavior needs, program needs, ethnic balance, student language needs, and gender balance. We will not accept requests for specific teachers. If you would like to give input regarding your child's educational needs, you must use the online Student Placement Consideration Form. This link is for Brookvale ONLY. Other schools have their own form. Letters will not be accepted. Parents must understand that only the educational needs of the student will be considered. Online forms must be submitted by April 20, 2023 at 4:00 pm. Forms received after this date will not be considered. #### BROOKVALE SSC/ELAC 2023-24 OPENINGS

The purpose of the School Site Council (SSC) and ELAC is to oversee the school programs that include the curriculum and best instructional practices. SSC is made up of the principal, parents and teachers, and ensures that the needs of every Brookvale student are met. The SSC monitors the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) Plan (see below). This group also oversees the spending of certain funds provided through LCAP (see below).

SSC is made up of an equal number of parents and staff. Parents are elected by parents, and staff are elected by the staff. These members represent the entire school community.

LCAP: Local Control Accountability Plan:

This is the plan developed to ensure continuous improvement of our school. We write the plan for Brookvale and ensure that it is aligned with the district's visions and goals. It is rewritten yearly to reflect the needs of our current students. It is available on the district website.

SPSA: Single Plan for Student Achievement: This plan is developed to make sure there is ongoing improvement of our school. The plan is written specifically for Brookvale on an annual basis to reflect the needs of all of our current students. It is available on the district website.

SSC meetings take place 5 times per school year. An agenda for each meeting will be posted on the website and outside the office at least 72 hours before the meeting date. All meetings are open to the public. Contact Mrs. Elliott to let her know you want to be part of the SSC TEAM for the 2023-2024 School Year.
