Reporting Your Student Absence: Please call the school office to report your child absent by following the prompts and leaving a message. Please speak *clearly* and leave your child's FIRST and LAST NAME, TEACHER'S NAME, GRADE and REASON FOR THE ABSENCE: Ill, out of town, etc. Please identify yourself as the parent/guardian and state your name. You may also email your child's absence information directly to Jennifer Mehta as noted above.

Signing Students Out Early: If you need to sign your child out of school for a doctor appointment early, please be prepared to show valid ID to confirm your identity as either the parent/guardian or approved emergency contact, arriving early and noting recess/lunch time schedules. Emailing the teacher as a courtesy is helpful.

2022-2023 Brookvale Volunteer Policy: All School Volunteers are Required to Register on CiviCore

It is a simple process. All volunteers will be required to upload their Driver's License. Parents volunteering to drive for a field trip are also required to upload their Automobile Insurance Declaration Page (which clearly lists liability amounts, names of covered drivers, vehicle make/model and vehicle license plate).
