The Chadbourne Parking lot will not be available for dropping off and picking up students. Parents are instructed to park safely in the surrounding residential area, following all traffic laws, (and not blocking the driveways of our Chadbourne neighbors) and walk your children to our campus.

Only staff members and students will be allowed in areas behind the designated areas or yellow lines. Parents/Caregivers must stay in front of the Chadbourne school office area while their child/children walk to their designated location to meet their teacher.

The same locations used for student arrival will be used for student dismissal. Parents/guardians are encouraged to pick up their child in the same place they were dropped off to avoid confusion. While picking up their child from school, all adults must wear a face covering. Families that elect to walk their children home may meet their child at the front of Chadbourne school office, flagpole, or in front of the picnic area. Students waiting for afterschool care providers must wait along the MUR wall that faces the school office.

2021-2022 Chadbourne Office Policy:

When possible, all questions, concerns, or inquiries should be conducted virtually via email or phone.

School visits that require physical interactions shall be permitted by appointment only.

2021-2022 Chadbourne Volunteer Policy:

- Until further notice, we sadly will not be welcoming parent/community volunteers on campus except for Library if needed and Safety Patrol (morning valet). As COVID conditions change, this policy will be revisited.
- If a parent/caregiver needs to physically visit a Chadbourne classroom teacher, prior arrangements must be made. We encourage parents to utilize electronic communications with your child's teacher.



To access your IC Parent Portal Account click on the link located in your **Fremont Unified School District email**, (*check your spam folder!*) it will take you to the FUSD Login screen as noted here.



Enter your username and the password you created. If you forgot your password, you will need to reset it. Please click on the "Forgot Password" button. If you do not receive the reset email within 24 hours (*remember to check your Spam folder*) then please email portalsupport@fusdk12.net. Office staff will be unable to help you with a password reset.

After you log into your IC Parent Portal, it will take you to the "Message Center." From there, click on "**More**" in the Menu Bar to the left of the screen.



From there, you will click on "Online Registration" and Chadbourne will show up. (Be sure to click on the **"Existing Student"** button). You will find instructions on the MAZE Day Forms [here](#).

IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT ATTENDANCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL & REASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS:

The 2021-2022 School Year begins on Wednesday, August 18, 2021. **All students are expected to report to school on the first day unless they are ill. Students who have not attended the first day of school will be dropped from school.** Parents must call in their child's absence and notify the school that their child is ill in order to save their seat. **Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.** If you returned after the start of school, you must first re-register your child with FUSD to find out what school they will be attending if your home school is full in that grade level.

COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES:

Chadbourne sends important information to families via our monthly newsletters as well as with automated calls and parent emails with important information via Bright Arrow. Teachers, our Principal, and our Parent group will also communicate with you through Konstella.com

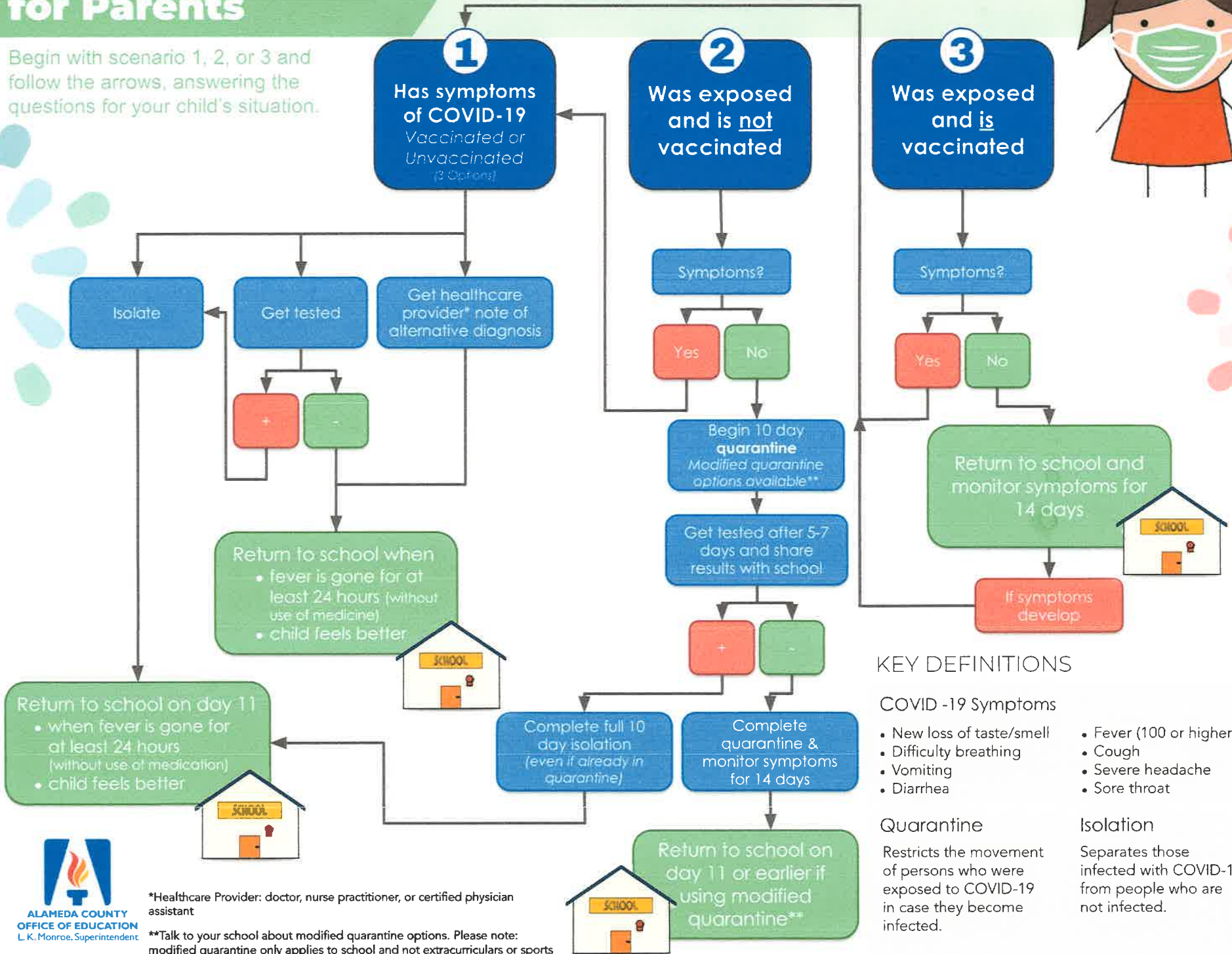

KEY DEFINITIONS

COVID -19 Symptoms

- New loss of taste/smell
- Difficulty breathing
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fever (100 or higher)
- Cough
- Severe headache
- Sore throat

Quarantine

Restricts the movement of persons who were exposed to COVID-19 in case they become infected.

Isolation

Separates those infected with COVID-19 from people who are not infected.
