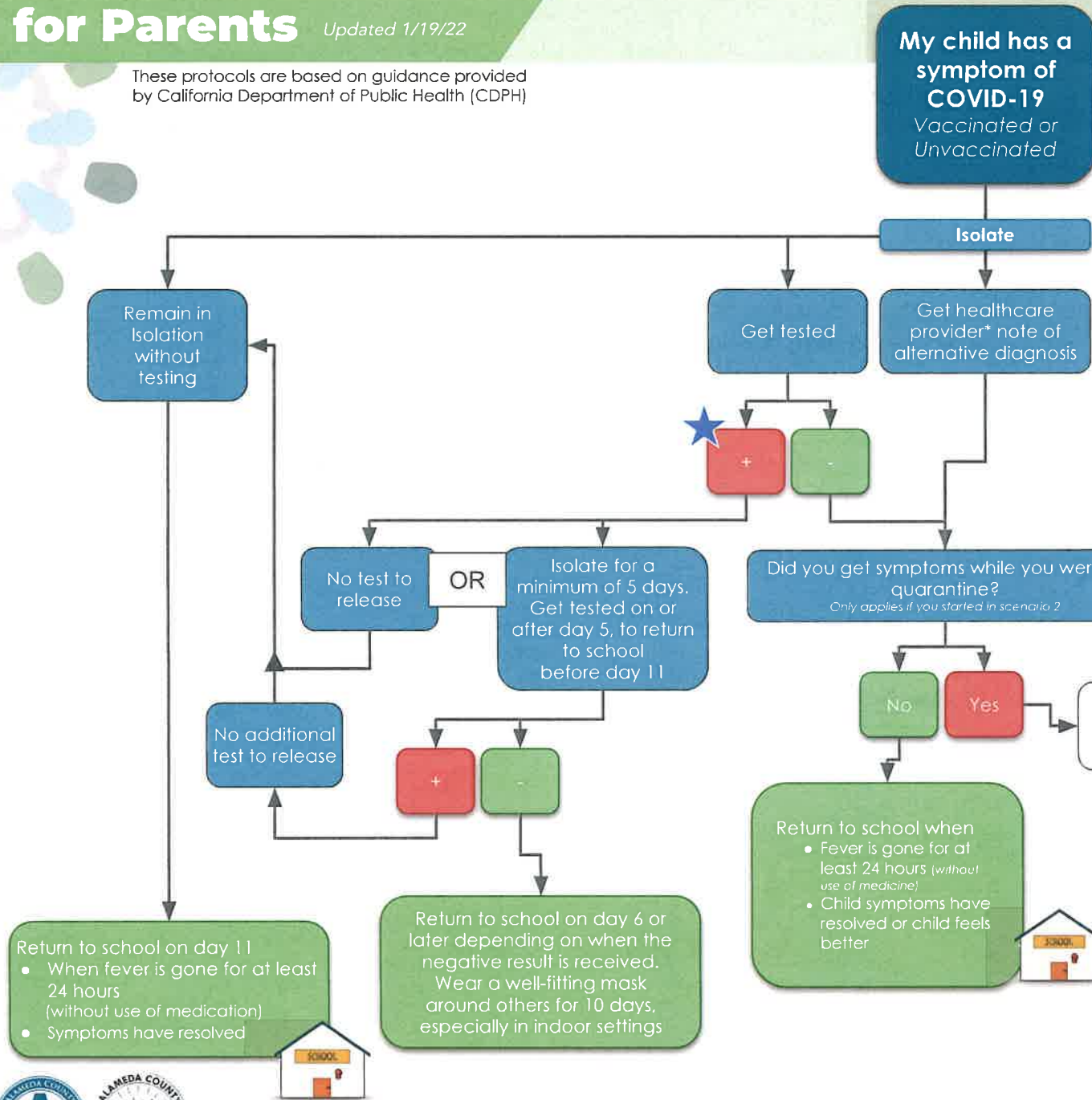

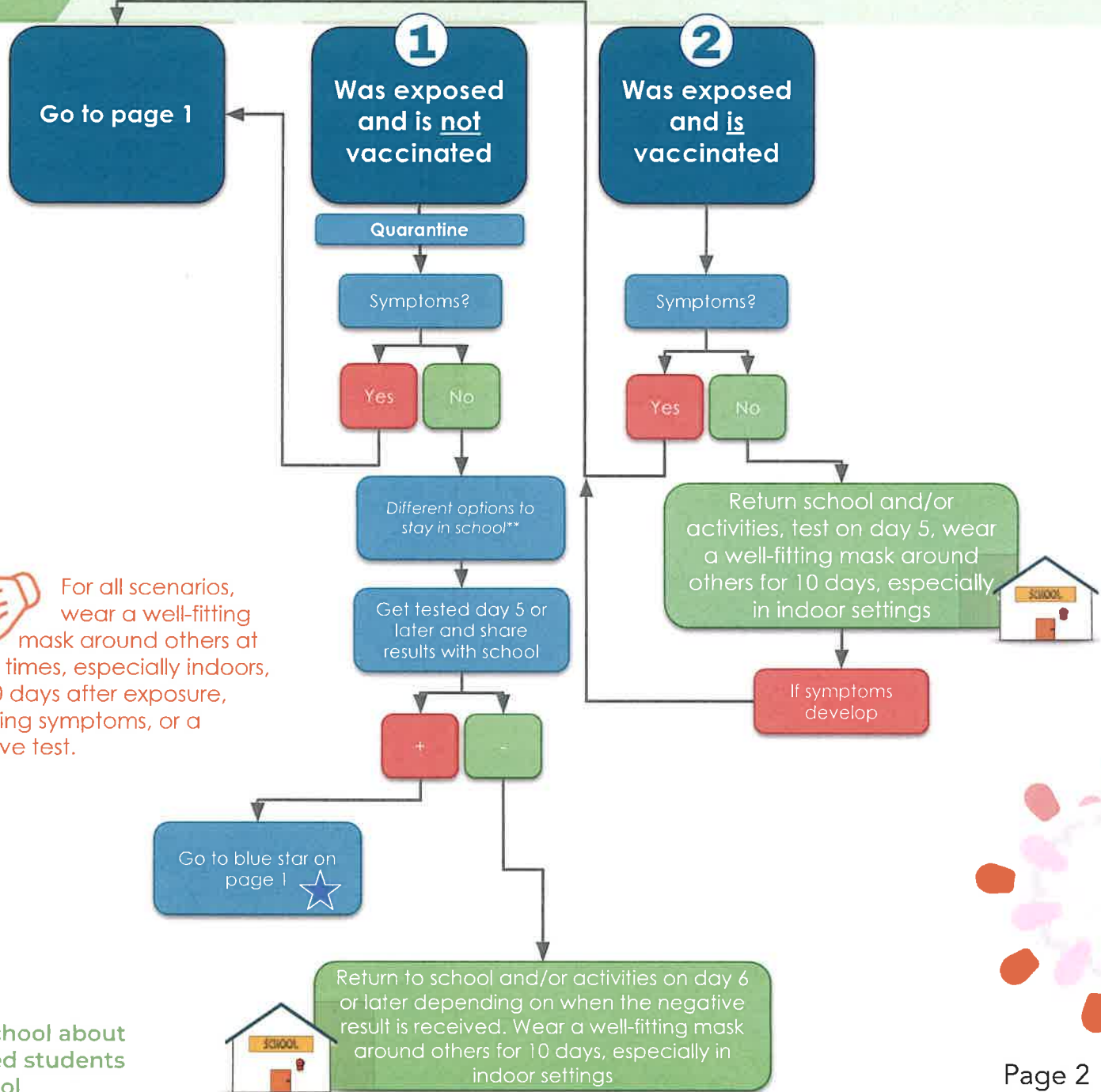

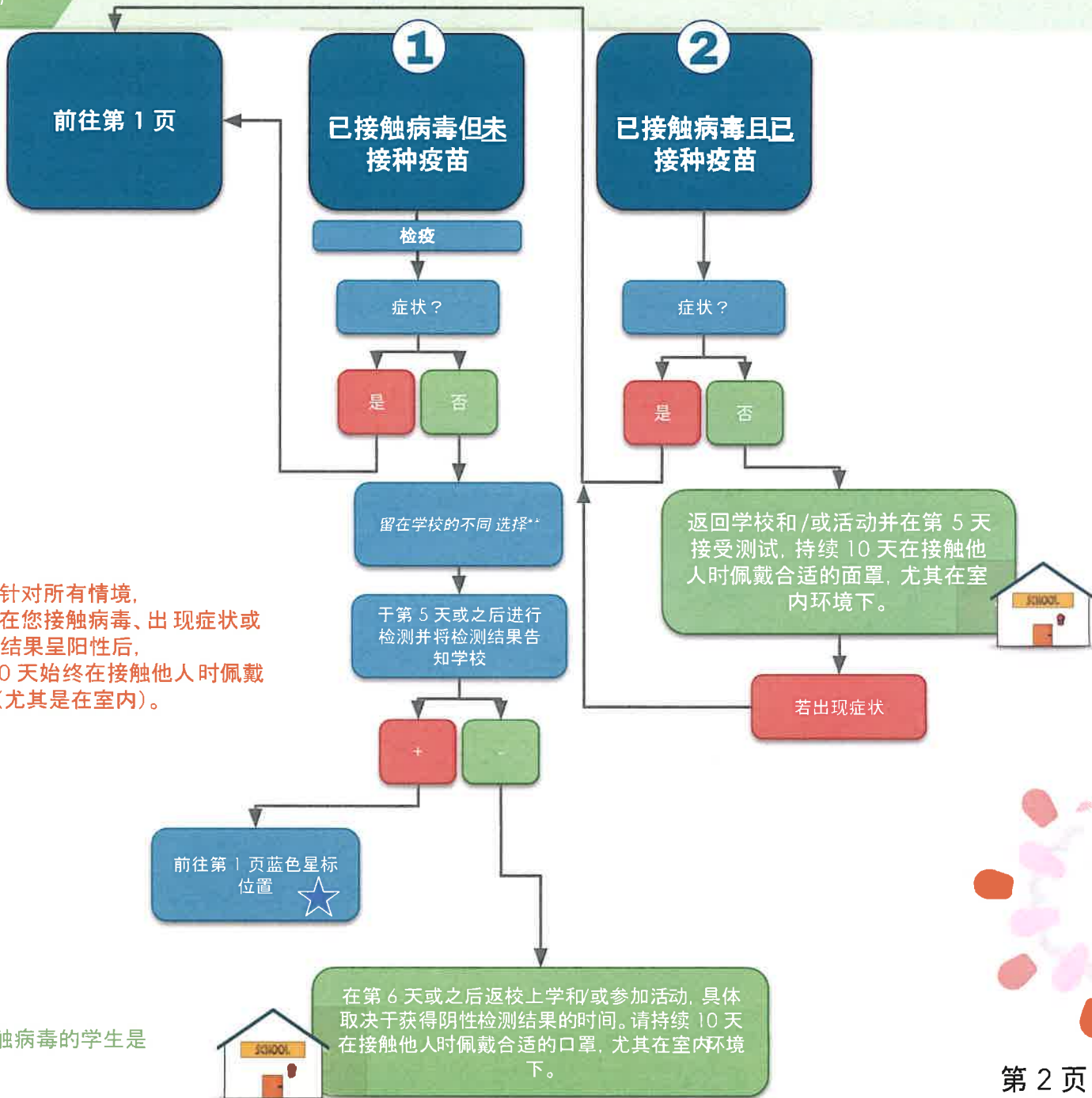

## Quarantine Independent Study Information

Dear Families,

We know that many of you have had to quarantine your student due to COVID symptoms. To ensure that we have continuity of instruction, and support students during this time, the district is offering short term and long term independent study options.

Per Assembly Bill 130, students who are quarantined due to COVID symptoms and will be out of schools more than 3 days, will continue to receive educational opportunities through a short term independent study contract. When the school district requires a student to quarantine, a student/family will be given a packet of grade level work and a short term independent study contract to complete. When the student returns from the quarantine, the completed packet and independent study contract should be returned to the school site.

In the case that a student has been quarantined for longer than 14 cumulative days, a student/family will be offered a long term independent study contract. Long term independent study will be conducted by a virtual teacher. The child will attend online classes daily for a check in and assignments will be given. Families will be given two links. One link for the Parent Agreement for the Long Term Independent Study and one link from the virtual teacher. The Parent Agreement is a form that must be filled out in order for your child to participate in long term independent study. We appreciate your compliance with completing both documents.

### Estudio independiente durante cuarentena

Estimadas familias,

Sabemos que muchos de ustedes han tenido que poner en cuarentena a su estudiante debido a los síntomas de COVID. Para asegurar que tengamos continuidad en la instrucción y apoyar a los estudiantes durante este tiempo, el distrito está ofreciendo opciones de estudio independiente a corto y largo plazo.

Según el Proyecto de Ley 130 de la Asamblea, los estudiantes que están en cuarentena debido a síntomas de COVID y estarán fuera de la escuela por más de 3 días, continuarán recibiendo oportunidades educativas a través de un contrato de estudio independiente a corto plazo. Cuando el distrito escolar requiere que un estudiante se ponga en cuarentena, se le dará al estudiante / familia un paquete de trabajo de nivel de grado y un contrato de estudio independiente a corto plazo para completar. Cuando el estudiante regrese de la cuarentena, el paquete completo y el contrato de estudio independiente deben devolverse a la escuela.

En el caso de que un estudiante haya estado en cuarentena por más de 14 días acumulativos, se le ofrecerá al estudiante / familia un contrato de estudio independiente a largo plazo. El estudio independiente a largo plazo será realizado por un profesor virtual. El niño asistirá a clases en línea todos los días para registrarse y se le darán asignaciones. Las familias recibirán dos enlaces. Un enlace para el Acuerdo con los padres para el estudio independiente a largo plazo y un enlace del maestro virtual. El Acuerdo con los padres es un formulario que se debe completar para que su hijo participe en un estudio independiente a largo plazo. Agradecemos su cumplimiento con la cumplimentación de ambos documentos.

隔離獨立研究

親愛的家庭們,

我們知道，由於 COVID 症狀，您們中許多人不得不隔離您的學生。為確保我們教學的連續性，並在此期間支持學生，學區提供短期和長期的獨立學習選擇。

根據議會 130 號法案，因 COVID 症狀而被隔離並將離開學校 3 天以上的學生，將通過短期獨立學習合約繼續獲得教育機會。當學區要求學生隔離時，學生/家庭將必須完成一份年級學習功課和一份短期獨立學習合約。當學生隔離結束時，應將完成的功課和獨立學習合約交回學校。

如果學生隔離累積超過 14 天，學生/家庭將獲得長期獨立學習合約。長期獨立學習將由線上教師進行。孩子將每天參加在線課程簽到並有分作業配。家庭將會收到二個連結。一個連結是長期獨立學習家長協議，和線上教師的連接。家長協議是必須填寫的表格，您的孩子才能參與長期獨立學習。感謝您配合完成這兩個文件。

When possible, all questions, concerns, or inquiries should be conducted virtually via email or phone.

All absences must be reported to the school office no later than 9am on the day of the absence. The attendance line is (510)656-5242 EXT 7. This phone system is available 24/7 for your convenience.

School visits that require physical interactions shall be permitted by appointment only.

### **Parking and "On Campus" Reminder**

The Chadbourne Parking lot will not be available for dropping off and picking up students. Parents are instructed to park safely in the surrounding residential area, following all traffic laws, (and not blocking the driveways of our Chadbourne neighbors) and walk your children to our Campus. Parents are not allowed to enter the campus beyond the yellow line. This is to ensure COVID protocols are being followed by all for the safety of our students and staff.

The same locations used for student arrival will be used for student dismissal. Parents/guardians are encouraged to pick up their child in the same place they were dropped off to avoid confusion. While picking up your child from school, all adults must wear a face covering. Families who elect to walk their children home may meet their child at the front of Chadbourne school office, flagpole, or in front of the picnic area. Students waiting for afterschool care providers must wait along the MUR wall that faces the school office. Parents/Caregivers must stay in front of the Chadbourne school office area while waiting for their child/children to be released from class.

### **Chadbourne SAFETY MESSAGE**

Parents/Guardians please remember:

- Students must be picked up on time after school. If students are not picked within 10 minutes of dismissal, parents/guardians are required to sign them out from the office.
- Drivers are not allowed to pull into the bus lane or block residential or school driveways to pick up/drop-off their student.
- Adults and students MUST use the crosswalk when crossing the street.
- Parents and students should never walk through the staff parking lots. Always walk on the sidewalk and walkways.
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS at school.

This testing is provided by FUSD for concerned students with any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 regardless of vaccination status or prior infection.

**Testing is available at your school site for students from that school.** If you are not able to make it to the designated testing day at your school, testing is available at the District Office, Monday-Friday from 7:00am-3:00pm on a drop-in basis. **Please either go to your school site or the District Office - other school sites are setup for students from that specific school not drop-ins from any school - thank you.**

Full day schedule from 7:00am-3:00pm

Parents wishing to have their student tested will need to register below. **Parents/Guardians will need to be present to test any elementary and middle school age student.** For high school students, parents/guardians do not need to be present to test.

Testing schedule can be found below Registration links on this page - it is the same for students and staff. A proctor will observe proper sample collection and ensure that each student has a unique test kit barcode number associated with their name. Results will be delivered to your email or phone number within 24-48 hours, depending on which type of messaging you chose during the registration process.

Each student will be provided a self-administered kit that contains comfortable anterior nasal swabs which the student will use to collect a sample (with help from parent/guardian as needed).

### STEP 3: TESTING PROCESS

**How does the testing process work?**

First register (links above) then find a day and time associated with your school. Each student will be provided a self-administered kit that contains comfortable anterior nasal swabs which the student will use to collect a sample (with help from parent/guardian as needed).

**How soon will I receive my results?**

Results will be delivered to your email or phone number within 48 hours, depending on which type of messaging you chose during the registration process.

**Will the test be proctored?**

A proctor will observe proper sample collection and ensure that each student has a unique test kit barcode number associated with their name. Results will be delivered to your email or phone number approximately 2-4 days depending on the capacity of the lab.
