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Dear Parent/Guardians,

i-Ready is a district-adopted assessment program that is used in grades 1-8 in FUSD for reading and mathematics, and grades 9-12 in FUSD for reading. Your child has recently completed an i-Ready assessment in reading and/or mathematics. Reports will be emailed home.

To help you understand your child's reports, we have included the following resources:

Students in grades 1-6 who completed the diagnostic assessment will have access to online i-Ready lessons based on their results. These lessons are unique based on your child's strengths and areas for growth.

Dear Families,

October is here! We have a lot of information to share in our newsletters monthly so please read them in their entirety.

Attendance Reminders (Thanks for being on time!):

- 1. Please alert the office (<u>vparikh@fusdk12.net</u>) or 510-657-3537 option 7 of your student's absence. Phone calls can be left at any time of the day. When calling in sick, we do need to know your student's symptoms.
- 2. Kindergarten should be in line at 8:15 but are late if arriving after 8:20. Grades 4-5 begin school at 8:22; Grade 1-3 begin school at 8:25.

Primary Lunch (Grades 1-3 time change): On Wednesdays only, our primary students will have lunch from 11:15-12. This is 15 minutes earlier than the previous schedule. We highly encourage you to teach your child to be responsible for bringing their own lunch but if you drop off a primary lunch on Wednesdays, it will need to be on the cart by 11 am.

Teachers sent home progress reports last week if your student was not meeting standards or partially meeting standards. This progress report means we are halfway through the trimester and each student will be receiving their trimester 1 grades in November at conferences.

WE NEED YOU! One way to get involved is to join one of our important committees which only meets 4 times a year and through Zoom. We are in need of more parents who would be interested in sitting on the School Site Council (SSC) which oversees our budget, makes decisions based on student needs, hear about school data and learn about past or upcoming events at these meetings. Two have already volunteered and we hope you can take a moment to vote for them here. Another committee is our English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC) which partners with school personnel to offer support, look at the mandatory spring test and give input as to how to help their children best acquire English skills to be successful in school. Please click the survey to vote and volunteer HERE if you are interested in being a valued member of our Hirsch community. All meetings take place over Zoom and the dates are on the survey. We are also always looking for additional noon supervisors.

I hope to see you next Tuesday, October 11^{th} at 9 am for the next Principal Coffee Chat.

The Book Fair will also be accessible during lunch to students who have brought money with them and after school if they are accompanied by an adult.
