

A message from Principal Arroyo

Dear Hirsch Families,

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! Our Hirsch staff is so excited to welcome our students back to

school on Wednesday, August 17th. We pride ourselves on building relationships with our students and their families and look forward to another year of working together. You are essential to the success of our Bulldog students!

As a reminder, please check your Infinite Campus Parent Portal for your student's teacher and room number that was posted on August 12th. Class lists are not posted at school. https://fremontunifiedca.infinitecampus.org/campus/portal/parents/fremont.jsp

With the first day of in person school on Wednesday, 8/17, please note:

- Masks are strongly recommended when indoors.
- Send your student to school with a water bottle for them to use.
- Attendance on the first day is mandatory. Any student absent on the first day will be dropped from school.
- One parent/quardian will be allowed to escort their child on campus for the first three days of school. Students must stay off playground equipment before school. Once your student's teacher arrives, please wave goodbye and quickly exit the campus. Beginning Monday, August 22nd, families will need to wait outside the gate for students.
- Different grades enter/exit through different gates. Grades 1-3 use #1, Grade K use #2, and Grades 4-5 use #3. (map diagram at the end)
- Families are unable to park in our school parking lot. We have designated spots for staff only.
- We highly encourage you to use our drive thru valet to drop off and pick up your student(s). Students must exit from the right passenger side when the car is along the blue Student Council benches. Adults should remain in their cars at all times with backpacks next to students and not in the trunk. Kinder students need to be walked to the gate and are unable to use the valet drop off.

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Have you completed your student's Online Maze Day Registration?

<u> 2022 – 2023 School Year Online Maze Day</u>

Beginning July 18, 2022, parents/guardians were able to complete their student's Online Maze Day registration for the 2022-2023 school year through their <u>Infinite Campus Parent Portal</u>. Your student's enrollment will be confirmed after your submission of the Online Maze Day registration. Submissions will be approved in the order they are received, and parents will receive an email verifying the information has been accepted.

The Online Maze Day Registration is Fremont Unified School District's annual registration and confirmation process in which parents/guardians:

- provide required information for each enrolled student such as emergency contacts and current proof of residency,
- acknowledge certain parent/guardian and student rights and responsibilities, and
- access specific school forms/information.

The window to complete the MAZE process for the 2022-23 school year is July 18 through August 16, 2022. Throughout the summer, parents/guardians received updated MAZE information at the email address indicated in the <u>IC Parent Portal</u>. PLEASE BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR SPAM FOLDERS.

Calling in Absences

If your student will not be attending their online class, please contact the school's absence line at 510-657-3537, then press 7. Please be sure to

state:

- 1. your student's name,
- 2. student's classroom number
- 3. reason for absence
- 4. your name
- 5. your relationship to the student.

If these absences are not cleared by a parent/guardian, they will be considered unexcused. Excessive absences and/or tardies, excused or unexcused, may result in a truancy warning. Make-up work may be requested on the second consecutive day of a student's illness.
