

Daily school attendance is extremely important to assure your child's maximum progress in school. If your child is absent, please call the school office at 657-0344, then **press 7**. This will connect you to our Absence Reporter where you can leave a message. Be aware that only illness, doctor/dentist appointments and bereavement are considered as excused absences. As required by Board Policy 5113, all absences must be verified by the office staff by either a telephone call or letter/doctor excuse. During distance learning, attendance is very important. Automatic calls are sent to students that are absent and parents must call the office or email the attendance clerk at tkaczmarek@fusdk12.net to indicate the reason for their absence.
