

Synchronous

Students learn at the **same time**.

Communication happens in **real time**.

Possibly more engaging and effective.

Allows for **instant feedback** and clarification.

Examples

Video conferencing, live chat, live streamed videos.

Asynchronous Students learn at different times. Communication is not live. Possibly more convenient and flexible. Allows students to work at their own pace.

xamples

Email, screencasts, Flipgrid videos, blog posts/comments.
