Old Business	Update on ELD scores and DELAC report	 ELD Update from Michelle Guerrero 19-20 ELPAC Test Data for all grades now available and was presented by Michelle. Michelle reviewed criteria/evidence for EL students to be reclassified, as well as next next steps involving parents and classroom teachers. Of all 113 students the average Overall Performance was a score of 3 (out of 4 levels). Michelle reviewed year over year goals for EL students. Only students with a score of 4 can be eligible for possible reclassification. Of Oliveira's 23 students 19 were up for reclassification. Students did not need to meet "met standard" per district cut score, instead they needed to meet district average. Michelle also reviewed the 20-21 timeline for

Intervention update from Linda Para-Educator will be assisting with K-1 Some grade level teachers will be doing before/after school intervention. PBIS update from Jenny Appelgren Jenny discussed how Oliveira began the journey/adoption for our Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) model to support student behavior. This is a multi-tiered system of support to meet all needs for all students. She reviewed what things are taking place at Oliveira at each level. 80%- level 1 15%- level 2 5%-level 3 -positive rewards -expectation framed in behavioral expectations -consistent intervention for misbehavior -behavior data tracking Improvementsstudent feeling safer on playground -consistent expectations from school staff -students feel they are being reported for positive behavior -teachers provided with additional support and outlined procedures for classroom/office/ and interventions.
		PBIS is expanding throughout FUSD. FUSD has a discrepancy problem with disciplining students. Students of color and with disabilities are disproportionately disciplined. Specific data/numbers were shared.

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		Kiely suggested using discretionary funds to help stock Ollie's Outpost for students to cash in their Caught Soarings.
		Elect New Chairperson update from Vidya Girish Vidya will be moving and stepping down from her role as chairperson. She shared what her role entailed.
