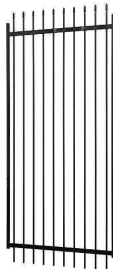

## Back Gate

In an effort to ease traffic congestion during arrival and dismissal times, Oliveira opens the "back gate" that leads to Blue Ridge Avenue for Grade 1-6 Students.

### Please help by:

- ⇒ understanding that the classrooms nearest the gate have instructional time until 2:55 p.m. four days a week and 1:15 p.m. on Wednesdays. Please be respectful of Oliveira Students' Learning Time!
- ⇒ waiting quietly outside the gate for your child/children to come to you after the 2:40 p.m. bell.
- ⇒ High School and Junior High School students must remain **off campus** until 2:55 p.m. Monday through Friday as TK/K classes are still in session. (BP/AR 5145).

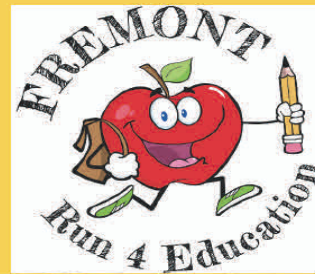
