Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Multiplication facts 0-10 memorized - Add and subtract multi-digit numbers within 1,000 with regrouping and ungrouping 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have your child play online math games on www.coolmath-games.com - Practice fact fluency with flash cards
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Decode multisyllable words - Verbally retell a short passage 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read a variety of books and talk with someone else about what they have read
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write complete sentences - Write a paragraph with a topic sentence, at least three supporting details, and a conclusion 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Practice writing by keeping a journal, writing friendly letters to friends and/or family, or writing about
Speaking and Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Restate up to three-step directions 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have your child repeat directions back to you when given
