Subject	Skills	How to Practice
Math	Know your basic multiplication problems fluently.	Flash cards, xtramath.com also works with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
Reading	Students should come to 5th grade with the stamina to read for 30 minutes with a chapter book.	Read “just right” books (at your reading level).
Writing	By fifth grade, students should understand and be able to identify a complete sentence, and to distinguish a sentence from a fragment. They should understand the concepts of subject and predicate.	Write letters and postcards to family members and friends. Keep a summer journal. Practice revising written work to add details, and edit for correct use of grammar and punctuation.
Speaking and Listening	Students should be able to stand in the front of the classroom to present, speaking loud enough for the classroom audience to hear.	Students should understand and practice different voice levels.
Social Skills	Students should come to school understanding general classroom norms.	Student should be able to follow verbal instructions. Understand that when the teacher is speaking, they should not speak, but listen.
