Subject	Skills	How to Practice
Math	-Telling Time to the nearest 5 minutes -Counting by 2s, 5s, 10s -Adding/Subtracting with regrouping/ungrouping	-Practice telling time on an analog clock - Give directions using time, i.e. "Be ready to go by 10:05." -Sorting and counting items in groups of 2s, 5s, and 10s -STMath.com -xtramath.org
Reading	-Fiction -Retell events of a story, including character, setting, and plot -NonFiction-retell main idea with supporting details -Decoding multisyllabic words	-Read a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts and summarize after reading, with an adult -Lexiacore5.com
Writing	-Capitalize the start of sentences and all proper nouns -Proper end marks -Descriptive detail (feel, sound, taste, smell, touch)	-Keep a summer journal and write in it daily. -Review some entries and revise and edit with an adult - Write postcards or letters to family, describing events or experiences with detail
Speaking and Listening	-Listen to and follow three step directions -Use appropriate voice level to the situation	-Give your child oral directions (1 time only) ex. Make your bed, brush your teeth, and get dressed. -Engage in conversations in different settings. ex. Library, park, playdate, in the car.
Social Skills	-Manners. ex. taking turns, saying "thank you and please" -Compromising ex. Listening to others' ideas, taking turns	-Unstructured playtime with peers -Organized sports/activities -Family meal time without electronics
