- Parent/guardian referral

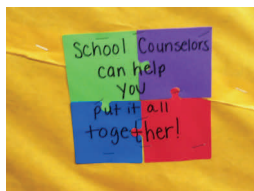


What Services are Offered:

I'm **Alanna Lee, R.N., the school nurse** for Oliveira Elementary. My job is to help all our students stay healthy so they can be at school.

Families, you can help keep your students healthy. All students need a good night's sleep, a nutritious breakfast before school, and plenty of exercise. You can also remind your student(s) that hand washing with soap and water is the best way to prevent illness.

I want all of our Oliveira students at school every day, but please have your student stay home if he/she has a rash or has had a fever over 100° F, has vomited, or had diarrhea in the last 24 hours.

If your student has a health condition and needs to have medication available at school, there are special forms for you and your child's healthcare provider to complete. You can get these forms from the school office or from the Fremont Unified School District website. The Oliveira office is not allowed to give students any medication without completed health forms.

During the year, you can e-mail me at alannalee@fusdk12.net. Be sure to contact me if your student has a special health need (like food allergies, asthma, diabetes, seizures, etc) that will need to be addressed at school.

Attendance on the First Day of School

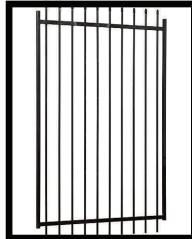
The 2019-20 School Year starts on Weds., August 28, 2019. All students are expected to report to school on the first day, Weds. 8/28/19. Students who have not attended on the first day of school will be dropped at the end of the first day of school. Students who are dropped will not be guaranteed a seat at the school and may have to be overloaded to other schools upon return. The only exceptions will be students who are absent due to illness. If a student is absent the first day due to illness, parent/guardian must notify the school every day the student is absent. **Seats will not be held for students on extended vacation or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.** (AR5113.1).

Interested parents should fill out an application and submit it to the Curriculum & Instruction Director, Mrs. Kim Kelly by the due date. 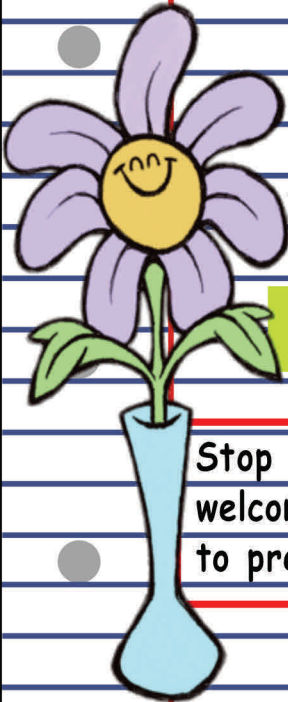
