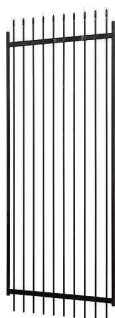

In an effort to ease traffic congestion during arrival and dismissal times, Oliveira opens the “back gate” that leads to Blue Ridge Avenue for Grade 1-6 Students.



Please help by:

- ⇒ understanding that the classrooms nearest the gate have instructional time until 2:55 p.m. four days a week and 1:15 p.m. on Wednesdays. Please be respectful of Oliveira Students’ Learning Time!
- ⇒ waiting quietly outside the gate for your child/children to come to you after the 2:40 p.m. bell.
- ⇒ High School and Junior High School students must remain **off campus** until 2:55 p.m. Monday through Friday as TK/K classes are still in session. (BP/AR 5145).

Student Safety Comes First: Blue Ridge is a street that goes in a circle back to Oak Street—Please go around the streets in a loop—u-turns are a student safety issue and should be avoided.

Donations and Lunches...use the online option!

Remember, you can pay for school lunches online using **MySchoolbucks**. School lunch money must be deposited on line or in the cash/check box in the school office to enable staff to ensure all students move through the lunch lines speedily.

You can also make a classroom donation, a field trip donation or donate to the library, science, music, computer lab or even PE! If you lost a textbook or library book, the payment should be made through MySchoolbucks.



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ELECTRONIC FLYER DELIVERY

FUSD delivers school information and approved flyers from community organizations electronically. School-approved eflyers will be emailed directly to you. Additionally, you can view these eflyers by clicking the Peachjar button on your school’s website.

This “green” initiative saves our schools tons of paper and reduces copy costs by thousands of dollars. On top of that, posting school flyers in this electronic backpack removes a significant administrative burden from teachers, office staff, and volunteers.

If we already have your email address, then no action is required on your part. You will receive a welcome email from our service provider (Peachjar) that includes a username and password if you do not currently have an account give you the opportunity to manage your account and flyer delivery preferences. You do not need to log in to receive or view school eflyers.

If you have not provided your email address, please do so to avoid missing important information. To ensure smooth delivery of this communication, we suggest you add “school@peachjar.com” to your email contacts. When you receive your first eflyer, be sure to click “always display images.”

This system is used exclusively for distribution of school-approved flyers. Your email address will not be shared or used for any other purpose. Thank you for supporting our efforts to ensure parents are well informed about school programs, activities, and events.
