Drop off and Pick Up Reminders

Please observe all traffic laws and speed limits in our school zone. When you reach our stop signs make sure your vehicle comes to a complete stop before proceeding.

If you are dropping your child off in the front or back loop, please make sure you remain in your vehicle at all times. Once your child is in the car we ask that you please exit the loop so that we can keep traffic moving. Pull up to the front of the loop so that we can keep the street clear as much as possible.

The parking lot in front of the MUR by the flagpole is off limits to all. That parking lot is designated for buses and other vehicles transporting our students with special needs.

The curve in front of the school has been designated as a no stopping zone at all times.

If you are walking with your child we ask that you stop at the intersection and ensure that it is clear prior to walking on the crosswalk. Please do not cross the street in front of the school and we ask that you use the crosswalk.

If your child is riding a bicycle or a scooter we ask that you please make sure that they are wearing a helmet at all times.

Coming in Late/ Leaving Early From School Procedures



If you are coming to school late, please bring your student to the office for a late slip and so that we can check them in.

If you are picking up your student early, please come to the front office and be prepared to show ID. Please allow time for us to locate your student, and for them to gather their belongings and walk to the office. We recommend avoiding picking up during recess and lunch.
