JFKHS Pillar Project Requirements and Standards

The pillar project is intended to clarify and standardize communication on the campus, and with this goal in mind, the requirements below will need to be addressed by all participants:

- 1. Pillars should clearly promote the name and purpose of the club/organization.
- 2. Pillars should have the club/organization's mission statement.
- 3. Pillars can have a section for posting upcoming events/calendar, but all events and promotions must be cleared with ASB/Mulcahy before being posted (this is a legal issue and must be adhered to for everyone's protection).
- 4. All designs must be approved by Leadership before work begins on the pillars.
- 5. All clubs/organizations are responsible for regular upkeep of their pillar in order to keep the campus looking clean, beautiful and spirited.
- 6. Each club's pillar must be renovated and refreshed at the beginning of each new school year.
- 7. Pillar location should be proposed for approval at the time of submission for your club's design. Leadership will take into consideration unity of surrounding pillars and overall campus unity when deciding club placement on pillars.
- 8. Clubs must design all four sides of the pillar.
- 9. All paints used must be weather proof.
- 10. Pillars will be inspected upon completion by Admin/ASB. Any concerns or problems with the design or execution must be addressed at that time.
