Mrs. Castillou, our Career/College Specialist, is at the College & Career Center daily from 7:30 AM until 3:30 PM. Students may visit to begin planning for life after high school. Resources are available on a multitude of occupations. Information for researching colleges, majors, and careers are continually updated. Students may meet with college admission representatives during lunch or after school; obtain SAT/ACT registration info and scholarship or financial aid information. Part-time jobs and volunteer opportunities are posted regularly on the Jobs Board. Students spend two to three periods each year at the College & Career Center with their English class where they have the opportunity to take interest surveys, focus on occupational choices and understand the requirements needed to pursue their career choices.

PSAT National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test: This test is excellent preparation & practice for the SAT Reasoning Test. It is useful to estimate your scores on the SAT and to compare with other sophomores/juniors across the country. Recommended for Sophomores in honors English and/or Math and for <u>all</u> Juniors wanting to take the SAT. The PSAT must be taken as a JUNIOR to qualify for National Merit Scholarship competitions. Watch for online registration information closer to the test date.
