TO CALCULATE YOUR GPA

For determining if you are eligible to apply to the University of California and the California State Universities, use only the grades earned in the required "a-g" subjects completed in grades 10-12 with extra points for up to eight semesters of UC-certified honors coursework. See the MSJ UC "a-g" Course List. The UC campuses use a variety of other GPA's in the admission process. Some schools will cap the gpa at 4.00 and some will use uncapped gpa's. Some will limit the number of extra points allowed for UC-certified honors, and some will have not limit on honors points.

The <u>underlined</u> courses on the a-g list, as well as UC transferable college courses, are the only courses that will receive extra points.
