Graduation Information

Graduation is June 8th at 6:00pm. There will be more detailed information coming soon, but for now please read the following rules and information when it comes to the Graduation Ceremony.

1. Students who wish to participate in the ceremony MUST attend graduation practice on June 6th.
2. There is no limit on the number of guests who can come to graduation.
3. A MAXIMUM of two leis may be worn during the ceremony. They must be professionally made and no candy leis are allowed. You may gift more leis after the ceremony is over.
4. Only cords and awards given at Senior Awards Night or through a club function may be worn at Graduation. The cultural stoles purchased are permitted as well. If an award falls outside of these groups, please ask Mr. Soltau.
5. Caps may not be decorated during the ceremony. Students may create a slip cover for their caps for photos for after the ceremony, but during the ceremony it must be black.
